GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION.

Order of His Excellency the Governor in Council under "The Interpretation Ordinance, 1901," and "The Public Revenue Protection Ordinance, No. 33 of 1921."

WHEREAS under and by virtue of the provisions of section 2 of "The Public Revenue Protection Ordinance, No. 33 of 1921," the Governor in Executive Council did make an Order dated the First September, 1921, directing the Principal Collector of Customs to demand and levy on the goods, wares, and merchandise mentioned in the schedules to the Bill set forth in the schedule annexed to the said Order the respective duties mentioned in the said schedules in lieu of the duties payable thereon respectively under the provisions of Ordinance No. 17 of 1869, or any Ordinance amending the same:

And whereas under and by virtue of the provisions of section 11 (1) (a) of "The Interpretation Ordinance, 1901," the Governor in Executive Council has power to amend, vary, rescind, or revoke any such Order as is above referred to:

And whereas it is expedient to revoke the Order firstly hereinbefore mentioned:

Now, therefore, I, Sir William Henry Manning, G.C.M.G., K.B.E., C.B., Governor as aforesaid, do hereby revoke the said Order, as on and from the Tenth day of September, 1921.
