

## Order under Section 2 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1908," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as reservation for road and reservation for ela, situate in the village of Barube, in the Mahagalboda Egoda korale of the Hiriyala hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."


