DRAFT ORDINANCES.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance further to amend Ordinance No. 15 of 1889, intituled "An Ordinance relating to Land Surveyors, Auctioneers, and Brokers."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend Ordinance No. 15 of 1889, intituled "An Ordinance relating to Land Surveyors, Auctioneers, and Brokers": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as "The Land Surveyors, Auctioneers, and Brokers (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1920."

Amendment of section 15 of the principal Ordinance. 2 Section 15 of the principal Ordinance shall be amended by the substitution of the figures "100" for the figures "80" in line 11 thereof.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THE object of the Ordinance is to make provision for the levy of a larger fee on brokers' licenses by the Colombo Municipality, which is in need of augmenting its finances. There would appear to be no justification for levying a smaller duty on a license for a broker than that for an auctioneer.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend "The Diseases (Labourers) Ordinance, No. 10 of 1912."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Diseases (Labourers) Ordinance, No. 10 of 1912": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title and commencement

Ordinance.

- 1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Diseases (Labourers) (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1920," and shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Governor by Proclamation in the "Government Gazette."
- Amendment of section 12 of the principal Ordinance is amended in the following respects:
 - (1) By striking out paragraph (a) thereof and inserting in its place the following paragraphs:
 - (a) Prescribing the location of cooly lines, the manner of, and plans for, their construction, and the materials to be used in their erection;
 - (a 1) Providing for the alteration, enlargement, or removal of cooly lines not built according to the rules made under this section, whether such lines were erected before or after the making of such rules;
 - (a 2) Providing for such alteration, enlargement, or removal by order of the Principal Civil Medical Officer when there is any contravention of any such rules, and for the recovery of the expenses thereof before the prescribed court;
 - (a 3) Providing for the inspection of cooly lines and their surroundings, and for the protection of the water supply of such lines.
 - (2) By inserting at the end of paragraph (c) thereof the words "and line refuse."
