DRAFT ORDINANCE.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance further to amend "The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Ordinance, 1909."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Ordinance, 1909": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Contagious Diseases (Animals) (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1920."

Amendment of section 9 of the principal Ordinance. 2 Sub-section (20) of section 9 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and the following sub-section shall be substituted in lieu thereof:

(20) For establishing and maintaining quarantine and inoculation stations for cattle and animals and for regulating or delegating the regulation of the management of the same, for the imposition, recovery, and disposal of fees for the use of such stations, for compelling cattle and animals to enter such stations, and for providing for the compulsory preventive inoculation of cattle or animals and for compulsory inoculation of the same for the purpose of diagnosing the nature of any disease.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THE object of this Bill is to repeal and re-enact with amendments sub-section (20) of section 9 of Ordinance No. 25 of 1909.

- 2. Sub-section (20) above-mentioned allows of provision being made for the establishment and maintenance of quarantine stations, but does not permit of the levying of fees for their use. As these stations are expensive to maintain, it seems but fair that persons using them should pay for their use.
- 3. The right to compel entry into quarantine stations may be exercised in cases contemplated by sub-section (19) of section 9 of Ordinance No. 25 of 1909, but it is thought well to confer the right to compel entry into a quarantine station in express terms.
