FINAL ORDERS.

Hambantota S. O. No. 1,645.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1908," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Maramandiyahena alias Uhapitiya, situate in the village of Bedigama, in the West Giruwa pattu of the Hambantota District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903.'

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on the 15th day of November, 1918, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Maramandiyahena alias Uhapitiya, situate in the village of Bedigama, in the West Giruwa pattu of the Hambantota District, in the Southern Province, containing in extent 44 acres 2 roods and 32 perches, and shown as lot 10p in block survey preliminary plan 261 and in the annexed diagram, was made to Arnold Langdon Crossman, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 7,053):




