PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir WILLIAM HENRY MANNING, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof,

WHEREAS under and by virtue of the provisions of clause 17 (2) of "The Ceylon (Legislative Council) Order in Council, 1920," power is given to the Governor in Executive Council to declare the limits, respectively, of Division A and Division B of the Western Province, for the purpose of elections to be held under the said Order: Know, therefore, that We, William Henry Manning, Governor as aforesaid, do hereby declare the limits, respectively, of the said divisions to be as set forth in the schedule hereto appended.

Given in Executive Council, this Thirtieth day of September, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Twenty.

SCHEDULE.

I.—Division A of the Western Province shall consist of all portions of the said Province lying to the north of the Kelaniya river.

II.—Division B of the Western Province shall consist of all portions of the said Province, excluding the area within the limits of the town of Colombo, lying to the south of the Kelaniya river.

IT is hereby notified for general information that all persons desirous of having their names inserted in the Register of Voters for any constituency created under the provisions of the said Order must, within one month from the publication of this Notification, forward their claims to the prescribed Registering Officers.

Claims relating to the Burgher, Commercial, Low-country Products Association, and Colombo Electorates must be forwarded to the Registering Officer respectively of each such Electorate, and claims relating to any other constituency to the Registering Officer of the electoral district within which the claimant resides.

Claims may be in the form prescribed in rule 1 (c) of Schedule I. to the said Order.
