GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION.

Armistice Day Anniversary.

IS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR desires to announce that it is the wish of HIS MAJESTY THE KING that the Second Anniversary of Armistice Day on November 11, 1920, should be celebrated by the cessation of all normal activities and the observance of Two Minutes' Silence at 11 A.M. on that day.

2. All Government Departments are directed to take the necessary steps to ensure the carrying out of this order, and all members of the general public are invited to co-operate accordingly.

3. His Excellency further desires that services should be held in all churches and other places of public worship on that day, and invites all religious authorities to make the necessary arrangements.
