GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS.

“THE HOUSING AND TOWN IMPROVEMENT ORDINANCE, 1915.”

BY-LAW made by the Board of Improvement of Nuwara Eliya, in pursuance of section 27 of “The Housing and Town Improvement Ordinance, No. 19 of 1915,” and approved by the Governor in Executive Council:—

The lands situated on either side of Park road, within a distance of 100 lineal yards from the centre of the said Park road, from the junction of the cross road between the Kachcheri and Malvern Cottages with the said Park road to the junction of the said Park road with the Railway Station-Scandal Corner road, shall be reserved for residential buildings only.

WITH reference to the Notification dated September 21, 1921, published in the *Government Gazette* of the 23rd idem, it is hereby notified that the price of Meedon rice at present being 21½ cents a measure, this rate should be taken as the basis for the purpose of calculating rice allowance.
