





The Government Agent of the Southern Province, is prepared to receive on or before Saturday, March 10, 1923, at the Galle Kachcheri, written applications for the lease, subject to the provision that rent shall be revised at every interval of 30 years, counting from the date of the commencement of the lease, from April 20, 1923, the under-mentioned portions of Crown land, to be planted with coconuts, rubber, tea, or cinnamon. No such applications will be entertained unless the applicant gives his full name and address, and until he makes with the Government Agent, Southern Province, a deposit of survey fees as noted against each lot. Such deposit will not be returned until the lease of the land has been sold, or until it has been decided by the Government Agent, Southern Province, that it will not be sold. On Tuesday, March 20, 1923, at 1 p.m., at the Galle Kachcheri, the sale of the lease will be put up to auction, in accordance with the regulations of the Government regarding the lease of Crown lands. The highest oidder for the premium shall be the purchaser of the lease, but the bidding shall be confined to the original applicant and those other applicants whose applications shall have been made in the manner above specified.

The conditions of lease are obtainable from the Government Agent, Southern Province, and their plans from the Surveyor-General.
