# Order under Section 2 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903,"

declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Moragahawellamukalana and Moragahawellamukalana (reservation for cart road), situate in the village of Arambepola, in the Udapola Medalassa korale of the Dambadenr hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

THE notice required by section 1 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," having been duly published in manner prescribed by that section in respect of the above-named lands (vide Notice No. 8,083), and no claim having been made to the said lands or to any interest therein within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, I, Norman Albert Hampton, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me in that behalf by section 2 of the said Ordinances, do hereby on this 21st day of January, 1923, order and declare that the said lands, as more fully described herein below, situate in the village of Arambepola, in the Udapola Medalassa korale of the Dambadeni hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and shown as lots I and 2 in advance extract No. 1 of block survey preliminary plan 682, and in the annexed diagram, and containing in extent 68 acres 2 roods and 29 perches, are the property of the Crown.



Lankaheneyalage Lapaya and (ii.) Lankaheneyalage Kiriridi the owner of 5 acres more or less of lot 49 of the notice and of the block survey preliminary plan 1,718, now shown as subdivisional lot 49 on the same plan, and (c) his being declared along with (i.) Lankaheneyalage Lapaya and (ii.) Lankaheneyalage Kirridi the purchaser of 2 acres more or less of lot 49 of the notice and of the block survey preliminary plan 1,718, now shown as subdivisional lot 49 on the same plan, and (c) his order ; and whereas the said 2nd and 3rd claimants entered into two agreements in writing dated the 17th day of September, 1921, and the 27th day of September, 1921, respectively, whereby in consideration of the block survey, preliminary plan 1,718, they withdrew their claims to the above-mentioned lot 49p of this order ; and whe

the said 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th, and 15th claimants for themselves, the said 16th claimant for himself and as duly appointed guardian of the said 17th minor claimant, and the said Udawewa Attanaheneyalage Ranaheneya as duly appointed guardian of the said 18th, 19th, 20th, and 21st minor claimants entered into an agreement in writing dated the 14th day of July, 1921, whereby in consideration of the Settlement Officer settling as private property outside the Waste Lands Ordinances lots 1, 3, 8, 8A, and 45 of the notice and of the block survey preliminary plan 1,718. they withdrew claim to the above-mentioned lot 49D of this order; I, Norman Albert Hampton, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me in that behalf by section 4 of the said Ordinances, do hereby on this 8th day of December, 1922, order and declare, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, that the said land, as more fully described herein below, is the property of the Crown.
