#### FINAL ORDERS.

#### Kurunegala S. O. No. 3,359.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Pita-ela (stream), Iswetiyawewa (tank and bund), &c., situate in the village of Radagama, in the Tissawa korale of the Dewamedi hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."


In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Kongahamulahena, situate in the village of Lokurugama, in the Giratalane korale of the Dewamedi hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."




