GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION.

WHEREAS smallpox has broken out in the Naval Hospital, Trincomalee, among men belonging to H. M. S. "Colombo," in the Trincomalee District, Eastern Province, it is hereby notified that His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council has been pleased to declare the locality described in the schedule hereto annexed to be a "diseased locality" for a period of six weeks from the date hereof, in terms of regulations framed under Ordinance No. 3 of 1897, published in the Government Gazette of July 31, 1914, and its subsequent amendments.

SCHEDULE REFERRED TO.

The buildings known as Naval Hospital, Marine View Bungalow, and workmen's cottages and grounds attached thereto, belonging to the Navy, situated at Trincomalee town, outside Local Board limits, and enclosed in the following boundaries:—

North by road leading to Dock Yard. West by the remaining Naval lands.

South and east by lands formerly possessed by the Military known as Ostenberg, and now in possession of Ceylon Government.
