Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."


In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Kumbukgahamulahena, situate in the village of Munihirigama, in the Giratalane korale of the Dewamedi hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 27th day of August, 1920, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Kumbukgahamulahena, situate in the village of Munihirigama, in the Giratalane korale of the Dewamedi hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, containing in extent 1 acre 1 rood and 1 perch, and shown as lot 39A in block survey preliminary plan 1,719 and in the annexed diagram, was made to Harry Chambers Toller, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 7,589).
