The Constituency of the European Electorate (Urban).

WHEREAS Mr. Herbert Gordon Bois, of Vauxhall street, Colombo, was duly elected as Member of the Legislative Council for the above-named constituency, at the election held at the Office of the Registrar-General, in Colombo, on April 16, 1923:
