**VITAL STATISTICS OF TOWNS IN CEYLON IN THE
MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 1921.**

REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL.

THIS report deals with the Vital Statistics of the 33 principal towns in the Island proclaimed under sections 31-36 of the Ordinance No. 1 of 1895.

Births.

2. The number of births registered was 1,982 (1,015 males and 967 females), and was equivalent to an annual rate of 41·73 per 1,000, against 39·81 in the preceding month, 31·83 in the corresponding month of last year, and 28·92 the average for the corresponding months since 1911. The rate ranged from 8·28 in Hatton-Dikoya to 74·43 in Moratuwa.

3. In the city of Colombo the births registered numbered 763 (394 males and 369 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 38·02 per 1,000, against 35·35 in the preceding month, 29·91 in the corresponding month of last year, and 23·66 the average for the corresponding months since 1911. The rate, exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards, ranged from 14·35 in Kollupitiya to 36·37 in Kotahena.

Deaths.

4. The total deaths registered during the month numbered 1,862 (993 males and 869 females). There were 1,454 deaths of residents in towns, equivalent to an annual standardized rate of 33·37 per 1,000, against 30·36 in the preceding month, 27·29 in the corresponding month of last year, and 30·51 the average for the month of November in each year since 1911. The rate ranged from 77·27 in Puttalam to 4·83 in Hatton-Dikoya.

5. In the city of Colombo the deaths numbered 648 (350 males and 298 females). There were 537 deaths of residents, equivalent to an annual standardized rate of 31·05 per 1,000, against 30·04 in the preceding month, 27·99 in the corresponding month of last year, and 29·84 the average for the month of November in each year since 1911. The rate, exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards, ranged from 30·31 in Kotahena to 10·08 in Wellawatta.

6. The stillbirths registered numbered 118 (70 males and 48 females), as against 128 in the preceding month.

Infant Mortality.

7. The mortality of infants under one year of age was equal to a rate of 248 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended November 30, 1921. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 225, against 224 in the preceding month, 243 in the corresponding month of last year, and 289 the average for the corresponding months since 1911.

8. In the city of Colombo the mortality of infants was equal to a rate of 232 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended November 30, 1921. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 216, against 221 in the preceding month, 249 in the corresponding month of last year, and 296 the average for the corresponding months since 1911.

Causes of Death.

9. The highest mortality was from *Debility*, to which 11 per cent. of the total deaths was due, *Pneumonia* and *Convulsions* caused 9 per cent. each, *Anchylostomiasis*, *Phthisis*, *Diarrhoea*, *Enteritis*, *Dysentery*, and *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia* 5 per cent. each, *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis* 4 per cent., *Enteric Fever*, *Prematurity*, and *Bronchitis* 2 per cent. each, and *Puerperal Septicæmia* 1 per cent.

10. In Colombo too the highest mortality was from *Debility*, to which 12 per cent. of the deaths was due. *Phthisis* caused 9 per cent., *Convulsions* and *Pneumonia* 8 per cent. each, *Enteritis* 4 per cent., *Enteric Fever*, *Anchylostomiasis*, and *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis* 3 per cent. each, *Dysentery*, *Diarrhoea*, and *Bronchitis* 2 per cent. each, and *Influenza*, *Cancer*, *Prematurity*, and *Puerperal Septicæmia* 1 per cent. each.

11. Three deaths from *Plague* were registered (in Colombo), as against 10 in the preceding month and 28 in the corresponding month of last year. One death from *Measles* (in Moratuwa) was registered.

12. *Infectious Diseases reported.*—The infectious disease most prevalent during the month was *Phthisis*, of which 99 cases were reported (89 in Colombo), *Chickenpox* followed with 75 cases (32 in Colombo, 16 in Kandy, 12 in Kegalla, 9 in Nuwara Eliya), *Enteric Fever* 52 (32 in Colombo, 8 in Moratuwa, 5 in Galle), *Continued Fever* 31 (22 in Colombo), *Dysentery* 12 (3 each in Moratuwa, Panadure, and Puttalam), *Measles* 11 (6 in Colombo), *Mumps* 10 (9 in Kandy), *Plague* 4 (in Colombo), *Diphtheria* 2 (in Colombo), and *Smallpox* 1 (in Colombo).

Meteorology.

13. *Rainfall.*—Mullaitivu recorded the highest rainfall (15·41 in.), followed by Jaffna (14·02 in.). In the other towns it ranged from 12·01 in. in Vavuniya to 3·46 in. in Colombo.

14. *Temperature.*—The mean temperature varied from 59·8° in Nuwara Eliya to 80·7° in Ratnapura, and was 80·6° in Colombo.
