It is further ordered that the will of Peter Manuel David, deceased above named, dated April 23, 1922, and now deposited in this court, be and the same is hereby declared proved, unless the respondents shall, on or before June 27, 1922, show sufficient cause to the satisfaction of this court to the contrary.

It is further ordered that the said petitioners are the executors named in the said will, and that they are entitled to have probate of the same issued to them accordingly.
