PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

Delegation of Powers by the Public Service Commission in terms of Article 57(1) of the Constitution

- 01. The Public Service Commission in terms of the Provisions in Article 57(1) of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka hereby delegates to the Public Officers stated in Column II of the Schedule "A" hereto, the powers set out in Column I thereof.
- 02. However, where there exists an uncertainty concerning the scope of any delegation of powers made by the Public Service Commission or the discharge of any delegation of powers so made by the said Commission, the decision of the Public Service Commission shall be final and conclusive.
- 03. Moreover, in the event that a Public Officer referred to in Column II of the Schedule hereto, is either the complainant or a witness or a potential witness at any disciplinary inquiry in respect of an officer belonging to a category set out in the corresponding item in Column I of the Schedule hereto, the powers delegated in respect of such officer shall be deemed to have been rescinded and the Public Service Commission shall exercise the powers so delegated in respect of such officer, as if no such delegation has been made in respect of such officer.
- 04. The provisions relating to the subject of Health concerning the delegation of powers set out in Part I of the Schedule published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1941/41 dated 20.11.2015 as amended by *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1955/22 dated 25.02.2016 that delegated powers in terms of Article 57(1) of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka are hereby rescinded, without prejudice to any action taken or purported to be taken under the Delegation of Powers published in the aforesaid *Gazette*.

- 01. The Public Service Commission in terms of the Provisions in Article 56(1) of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka hereby delegates to the Health Service Committee appointed by the Public Service Commission as stated in the Schedule "B" hereto, the powers set out in Column II in respect of the category of officers stated in Column I thereof.
- 02. However, where there exists an uncertainty concerning the scope of any delegation of powers made by the Public Service Commission or the discharge of any delegation of powers so made by the said Commission, the decision of the Public Service Commission shall be final and conclusive.
- 03. All matters pertaining to the powers delegated to the Health Service Committee that are pending before the Public Service Commission or the Secretary to the Ministry of the Minister in charge of the subject of Health on the date prior to the effective date of this delegation of powers shall, from the effective date of this delegation of powers, be vested in the Health Service Committee.
