**VITAL STATISTICS OF TOWNS IN CEYLON IN THE
MONTH OF FEBRUARY, 1922.**

REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL.

THIS report deals with the Vital Statistics of the 33 principal towns in the Island proclaimed under sections 31-36 of the Ordinance No. 1 of 1895.

Marriages.

2. The number of marriages of residents in the proclaimed towns was 379 (317 General, 3 Kandyan, and 59 Muhammadan), as against 397 in the preceding month.

Births.

3. The number of births registered was 1,545 (828 males and 717 females), and was equivalent to an annual rate of 33·30 per 1,000, against 37·22 in the preceding month, 29·97 in the corresponding month of last year, and 30·06 the average for the corresponding months since 1912. The rate ranged from 10·95 in Trincomalee to 69·05 in Nuwara Eliya.

4. In the city of Colombo the births registered numbered 573 (310 males and 263 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 30·16 per 1,000, against 31·14 in the preceding month, 22·85 in the corresponding month of last year, and 25·48 the average for the corresponding months since 1912. The rate, exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards, ranged from 14·62 in Kollupitiya to 32·09 in Wellawatta South.

Deaths.

5. The total deaths registered during the month numbered 1,792 (1,019 males and 773 females). There were 1,411 deaths of residents, equivalent to an annual standardized rate of 33·15 per 1,000, against 35·18 in the preceding month, 37·23 in the corresponding month of 1921, and 33·03 the average for the month of February in each year since 1912. The rate ranged from 111·35 in Vavuniya to 10·04 in Kegalla.

6. In the city of Colombo the deaths numbered 657 (385 males and 272 females). There were 549 deaths of residents, equivalent to an annual standardized rate of 33·53 per 1,000, against 36·40 in the preceding month, 32·25 in the corresponding month of 1921, and 29·03 the average for the month of February in each year since 1912. The rate, exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards, ranged from 32·25 in Kotahena South to 8·62 in Kollupitiya.

7. The stillbirths registered numbered 113 (65 males and 48 females), as against 131 in the preceding month.

Infant Mortality.

8. The mortality of infants under one year of age was equal to a rate of 233 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended February 28, 1922. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 255, against 266 in the preceding month, 295 in the corresponding month of 1921, and 258 the average for the corresponding months since 1912.

9. In the city of Colombo the mortality of infants was equal to a rate of 211 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended February 28, 1922. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 248, against 297 in the preceding month, 318 in the corresponding month of 1921, and 265 the average for the corresponding months since 1912.

Causes of Death.

10. The highest mortality was from *Pneumonia*, to which 13 per cent. of the total deaths was due, *Debility* caused 10 per cent., *Convulsions* 8 per cent., *Anchylostomiasis*, *Phthisis*, and *Malaria and Malarial Cachexia* 5 per cent. each, *Dysentery*, *Diarrhoea*, and *Enteritis* 4 per cent. each, *Bright's Disease and Nephritis and Influenza* 3 per cent. each, and *Enteric Fever, Bronchitis, Prematurity, and Puerperal Septicæmia* 2 per cent. each.

11. In Colombo too the highest mortality was from *Pneumonia*, to which 14 per cent. of the deaths was due, *Convulsions* caused 10 per cent., *Phthisis* 9 per cent., *Debility* 8 per cent., *Influenza* 5 per cent., *Enteritis and Bronchitis* 4 per cent. each, *Diarrhoea, Enteric Fever, and Malaria and Malarial Cachexia* 3 per cent. each, *Bright's Disease and Nephritis and Dysentery* 2 per cent. each, and *Plague, Anchylostomiasis, and Cancer* 1 per cent. each.

12. Nine deaths from *Plague* were registered (in Colombo), as against 13 in the preceding month, and 53 in the corresponding month of 1921. There was also registered 1 death from *Measles* in Moratuwa.

13. *Infectious Diseases reported.*—The infectious disease most prevalent during the month was *Chickenpox*, of which 157 cases were reported (105 in Colombo, 22 in Kandy, 7 in Kalutara, 7 in Galle), *Phthisis* followed with 116 cases (109 in Colombo), *Enteric Fever* 35 (20 in Colombo, 6 in Galle), *Continued Fever* 32 (24 in Colombo, 6 in Galle), *Measles* 17, 8 in Colombo), *Plague* 10 (in Colombo), *Dysentery* 5 (3 in Puttalam), *Diphtheria* 3 (2 in Panadura), *Smallpox* 2 (in Colombo), and *Mumps* 1 (in Colombo).

Meteorology.

14. *Rainfall.*—Mannar recorded the highest rainfall (14·75 in.), followed by Vavuniya (11·99 in.). In the other towns the rainfall ranged from 7·75 in. in Kalmunai to 0·66 of an inch in Tangalla. Colombo recorded 2·12 in.

15. *Temperature.*—The mean temperature varied from 58·1° in Nuwara Eliya to 81·4° in Ratnapura, and was 79·8° in Colombo.
