By His Excellency Sir WILLIAM HENRY MANNING, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the 29th day of April, 1921, and published in the *Government Gazette* of the 6th day of May, 1921, His Excellency the Governor, under the provisions of clause 58 of "The Ceylon (Legislative Council) Order in Council, 1920," appointed that the first session of the Legislative Council should be held in the Council Chamber, Colombo, and that the first sitting thereof should begin at 2.30 p.m. on Tuesday, the 7th day of June, 1921 :

And whereas by clause 59 of the said Order it is enacted that the Governor may at any time, by Proclamation, prorogue the said Council :

Know Ye that We, the Governor, do hereby prorogue the said Council.

Know Ye that We, the Governor, do hereby appoint that a session of the said Council shall be held in the Council Chamber, Colombo, and that the first sitting thereof shall begin at 2.30 P.M. on Thursday, the 8th day of June, 1922.
