- (4) In article 1 (x.) of the Treaty of Peace (Hungary) Order, 1921, as amended by the Amending Order, the reference to the Lord Chancellor, or, in Scotland, the Court of Session, shall be taken to be to the Chief Justice.

WHEREAS the contingent expenditure required for the service of the Government of this Island for the financial year October, 1922, to September, 1923, and not otherwise provided for, has been estimated at the sum of Ninety-two million Five hundred and Nine thousand Two hundred and Five rupees: It is enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

2 And whereas by the 31st section of the Ordinance No. 31 of the year 1884, entitled "An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 10 of 1861, entitled 'An Ordinance to consolidate and amend the Laws relating to Public Thoroughfares in this Colony,'" it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor to propose the estimates prepared in pursuance thereof, or such of them as to him may appear expedient, in the Ordinance for making provision for the contingent expenditure of the Colony for the ensuing year, to be dealt with in like manner as any other estimate to be so proposed: And it is thereby also provided that the amount of labour to be supplied under the provisions of the said Ordinance No. 31 of 1884, for the performance of any work or works for which an estimate or estimates may have been so proposed by the Governor, and approved of by the Legislative Council, shall be distinctly stated in the Ordinance enacted for the same, and that the same shall not exceed two-thirds of the whole amount of labour due from the district or districts within which it may be required to be performed: It is enacted that the amount of labour to be supplied under the provisions of the said Ordinance shall be in conformity with the estimates detailed under Head No. 40, "Public Works Annually Recurrent."

3 The Treasurer of the said Island shall issue and pay the said several sums to such persons, for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor for the time being, by any warrant or order in writing to be signed by him, shall from time to time order and direct; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the revenues and other funds of the said Island.

4 The said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid; and the receipt or receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sum or sums as shall be herein mentioned; and he shall and may receive credit for the same accordingly.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance further to amend "The Ceylon Railways Ordinance, 1902."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Ceylon Railways Ordinance, 1902": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Ceylon Railways (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1922."

Amendment of section 5 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 5 of the principal Ordinance shall be amended by the deletion of the word "for" in line 6 thereof.

Substitution of new schedule.

3 For the schedule of the principal Ordinance referred to in section 5 thereof the following schedule shall be substituted:

SCHEDULE.

Rate of Railway Fares.

Passengers.

- 1st class, not exceeding 20 cents per mile.
- 2nd class, not exceeding 10 cents per mile.
- 3rd class, not exceeding 4 cents per mile.

Reductions to be made for children, pioneers, and coolies of any nationality, and for return or periodical tickets. The right of reduction in the case of children must be determinable either by age or height, as shall from time to time be provided for by the rules.

Special trains or reserved accommodation shall be charged for at special rates. Special rates shall be charged for H, C, and D traffic, luggage, and parcels.

Goods.

- 1st class, from 24 cents to 59 cents per ton per mile.
- 2nd class, from 16 cents to 44 cents per ton per mile.
- 3rd class, from 12½ cents to 30 cents per ton per mile.
- 4th class, from 10 cents to 24 cents per ton per mile.
- 5th class, from 8 cents to 24 cents per ton per mile.
- 6th class, from 4 cents to 20 cents per ton per mile.

Special rates to be charged for live stock, corpses, specie, plate, carriages, and for articles exceeding 3 tons in weight or measuring more than 200 cubic feet in bulk or 14 feet in length, and gun-powder, kerosine oil, and other volatile oils, vitriol, lucifer matches, and other articles which, in the judgment of any of the railway officials, may be of a dangerous nature.

As respects goods, the fractional part of half a hundredweight shall be reckoned as half a hundredweight.

Articles not herein enumerated to be charged according to any of the above classes, or at special rates, according to the provisions to be made from time to time in the rules and regulations.

The minimum distance on which a mileage charge shall be made is ten miles.

Goods of the 6th class in quantities less than 4 tons to be charged as 4 tons, or at 3rd class rate on actual weight, whichever is lower.

The minimum charge for a consignment of goods is 25 cents.

Demurrage, insurance on valuable articles, warehouse, loading, and like charges shall be made in addition to the above rates, which apply only to the carriage of goods.

Definition of Classes.

- CLASS 1.—Acids, gunpowder, and other dangerous articles, pianos or other musical instruments, and plate glass.
- CLASS 2.—Furniture, wine, or other liquors in bottle, groceries, oilmanstores, millinery, textile fabrics, glassware, crockery, and unpacked machinery.
- CLASS 3.—Rice, grain of all kinds in bags or packages or in bulk, oil, wine, or other liquor in casks, jute, horns, jaggery, sugar, cinnamon, plants, seed, refined salt or saltpetre, bales of unmanufactured cotton, cordage, machinery packed in cases, manufactured metals, coir matting, castings, soap, hardware, tools, and agricultural implements.
- CLASS 4.—Tea, coffee, cacao, coconut palm produce, country-grown grain, fibre, and wrought timber.
- CLASS 5.—Fruit, vegetables, and unwrought timber.
- CLASS 6.—Coke, coal, minerals, bricks, lime, tiles, and stone, unworked metals, manure, firewood, and liquid fuel.

As respects passenger and goods traffic, the fractional part of a cent will be charged as a cent, and the fractional part of a mile will be charged as a mile.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance further to amend "The Irrigation Ordinance, No. 45 of 1917."

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Irrigation Ordinance, No. 45 of 1917": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Preamble.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Irrigation (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1922."

Short title.

2 The following proviso shall be inserted at the end of section 20 of the principal Ordinance :

Insertion in principal Ordinance of proviso to section 20.

Provided always that, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this section contained, the Government Agent may, if in his opinion and in that of the district advisory committee it is not advisable to proceed to an election of irrigation headmen, refrain from doing so for such time as the Government Agent and the district advisory committee may think proper.

3 The following section shall be inserted in the principal Ordinance immediately after section 20 thereof, and shall be numbered 20 A :

Insertion of new section in the principal Ordinance.

20 A. The Government Agent may, by writing under his hand, appoint officers whose duty it shall be, subject to the general or specific directions of the Government Agent, to assist the Government Agent in exercising and carrying out the powers and duties conferred or imposed upon him under the provisions of this chapter or any rules made thereunder.

Amendment of section 21 of the principal Ordinance.

4 Section 21 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended: (a) By inserting at the end of sub-section (1) thereof the words "and presided over by him or by any officer deputed by the Government Agent in that behalf"; (b) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:

(6) If in the opinion of the Government Agent and the district advisory committee there has, in any district or area for which an irrigation headman or headmen has or have been elected, ceased to be any need for the services of such headman or headmen, the Government Agent may summon a meeting of the proprietors of such district or area for the purpose of deciding the matter, and if the majority of the proprietors of the district or area decide that such services are not required, such headman or headmen shall thereupon cease to hold office and to exercise and perform any of the powers and duties conferred upon irrigation headmen under the provisions of this Ordinance.

Amendment of section 17 of the principal Ordinance.

5 Section 17 of the principal Ordinance is amended by striking out the figures "10" and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "11."

6 (1) Section 22 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the word "committed" in line 1 thereof the words "or an omission made."

(2) Immediately after the word "act" wherever it occurs in sections 22, 23, and 29 of the principal Ordinance, except where it first occurs in section 22, there shall be inserted the words "or omission."

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

By section 20 of the Irrigation Ordinance, No. 45 of 1917, provision is made for the election of irrigation headmen who are, "subject to the direction and control of the Government Agent," to attend to irrigation and cultivation matters, and to see that the rules made under the Ordinance are duly carried out.

It is obvious that the Government Agent cannot himself devote to these matters the time required, and it is proposed by section 3 of the Bill to give him power to appoint officers to assist the Government Agent in carrying out the duties and powers imposed or conferred on the latter by the provisions of Chapter IV. of the Ordinance.

Another difficulty has occurred in the working of Chapter IV. of the Ordinance. It has been found that in certain quarters proprietors are opposed to the election of irrigation headmen on the ground that, having regard to local conditions, there is no need for their services. Under Chapter IV. the Government Agent has no option but to summon meetings of proprietors for the purpose of electing irrigation headmen, and, in the event of failure to elect by the proprietors, to appoint headmen himself. It is proposed by section 2 of the Bill to empower the Government Agent, if in his opinion and in that of the district advisory committee it is not advisable to have headmen in any district or area, to refrain from holding any election for such time as the Government Agent and district advisory committee may think proper.

Section 4 of the Bill proposes to authorize the proprietors to decide, even where irrigation headmen have been elected, that they are no longer needed and to dispense with their services. It also authorizes the Government Agent to depute one of his officers to preside at elections of irrigation headmen (sub-section 13 (2) of the Irrigation Ordinance).
