PASSED ORDINANCE.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 14 of 1922.

An Ordinance further to amend "The Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance, 1895."

W. H. MANNING.

HEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance, 1895": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Preamble.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Births and Deaths Registration (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 14 of 1922," and shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by the Governor in Executive Council by Proclamation in the Government Gazette.

Short title and commencement,

Amendment of section 7 of the

principal Ordinance

2 Section 7 of the principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) By striking out the word "Governor" in line 1 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "Registrar-General."(b) By striking out the words "Registrar-General" in line 8 thereof.

Amendment of section 11 of the principal Ordinance

8 Section 11 of the principal Ordinance is amended by striking out the word "Governor" in line 6 of sub-section (1) and inserting in line thereof the words "Registrar-General."

> Amendment of section 20 of the principal Ordinance

4 Section 20 of the principal Ordinance is amended by striking out the words " and not more than seven years after the birth of any child" in lines 1 and 2 of paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) thereof.

Existing registrars.

5 Anything in this Ordinance contained notwithstanding, all persons holding the office or performing the duties of Registrars of Births and Deaths at the time of the commencement of this Ordinance shall continue to hold the office and perform the duties of Registrars of Births and Deaths under the principal Ordinance; and to exercise all the powers and privileges and be subject to all the liabilities vested in and imposed upon such officers by the principal Ordinance.
