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## FINAL ORDERS.

#### - Kurunegala S. O. No. 3,268.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Kahatagahamulahenyaya, Kongahamulahena, and Bogahamulahena, situate in the village of Bogahawatta, in the Giratalane korale of the Dewamedi hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEAEAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on the 22nd day of October, 1920, that if no claim to the lands commonly called or known as Kahatagahamulahenyaya, Kongahamulahena, and Bogahamulahena, situate in the village of Bogahawatta, in the Giratalane korale of the Dewamedi hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, containing in extent 26 acres and 2 roods, and sh wn as lots 2, 2B, and 18A in block survey preliminary plan 1,756 and in the annexed diagrams, was made to Harry Chambers Toller, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such lands would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 7,634):

writing dated the 9th day of May, 1921, whereby in consideration of (a) the Settlement Officer settling as private property outside the Waste Lands Ordinances (i.) lot 10 of the notice and of the block survey preliminary plan 1,756, and (ii.) 8 acres more or less of lot 18 of the notice and of the block survey preliminary plan 1,756, now shown as subdivisional lot 18 on the same plan, and (b) her being declared the purchaser of 1 acre more or less of lot 2 of the notice and of the block survey preliminary plan 1,756, now shown as lot 2A on the same plan, upon payment to the Government Agent at Kurunegala or to the Settlement Officer, on or before the 9th day of Angust, 1921, of a sum of Rupees Sixteen only (Rs. 16) she withdraw her claim to the result of the set o (Rs. 16), she withdrew her claim to the above-mentioned lots 2, 2B and 18A of this order; and whereas the said 5th claimant entered into an agreement in writing dated the 9th day of May, 1921, whereby in consideration of (a) the Settlement Officer settling as private property outside the Waste Lands Ordinances (i.) lot 10 of the notice and of the block survey preliminary plan 1,756, and (ii.) 8 acres more or less of lot 18 of the notice and of the block survey preliminary plan 1,756, now shown as sub-divisional lot 18 on the same plan, and (b) his being declared the purchaser of 1 acre more or less of lot 2 of the notice and of the block survey preliminary plan 1,756, upon payment to the Government Agent at Kurunegala or the Settlement Officer, on or before the 9th day of August, 1921, of a sum of Rupees Sixteen only (Rs. 16), he withdrew his claim to the remainder of the noticed lot 2 of the block survey preliminary plan 1,756, and to the abovementioned lot 18A of this order; and whereas it was further agreed that in default of such payment the claim of the said 5th claimant to the said portion of land in respect of which the said payment was to be made should also be considered to have been withdrawn, and the said portion of land should be declared to be the property of the Crown; and whereas the date for payment was extended to the 27th day of September, 1921; and whereas the said 5th claimant has failed to make the said payment of Rupees Sixteen only (Rs. 16), as the purchase amount of the said 1 acre more or less of lot 2 by the due date; and whereas his claim to the said 1 acre more or less of lot 2 of the notice and of the block survey preliminary plan 1,756 is considered to have been withdrawn; and whereas the said 6th and 7th claimants having been duly called upon by notice in writing under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, duly served upon them to produce before me, Norman Albert Hampton, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, the evidence and documents upon which they might rely in proof of their claims, did not so appear or produce such evidence and documents ; I, Norman Albert Hampton, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me in that behalf by section 4 of the said Ordinances, do hereby on this 19th day of June, 1922, order and declare, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, that the said lands, as more fully described herein below, are the property of the Crown.
