#### Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Godayayehena, Kongahamulahena, and Dangahamulahena, situate in the village of Madige Anukkane, in the Giratalane korale of the Dewamedi hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."
