**VITAL STATISTICS OF TOWNS IN CEYLON IN THE
MONTH OF AUGUST, 1922.**

REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL.

This report deals with the Vital Statistics of the 33 principal towns in the Island proclaimed under sections 31-36 of the Ordinance No. 1 of 1895.

Marriages.

2. The marriages of residents in proclaimed towns numbered 296 (210 General, 5 Kandyan, and 81 Muhammadan), as against 373 in the preceding month. In Colombo the marriages of residents numbered 120 (68 General and 52 Muhammadan), as against 135 in the preceding month.

Births.

3. The births registered numbered 1,565 (807 males and 758 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 30·46 per 1,000, against 28·50 in the preceding month, 29·58 in the corresponding month of last year, and 25·25 the average for the corresponding months since 1912. The rate ranged from 12·34 in Vavuniya to 89·29 in Lunugala.

4. In the city of Colombo the births registered numbered 556 (285 males and 271 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 26·44 per 1,000, against 24·20 in the preceding month, 24·96 in the corresponding month of last year, and 20·68 the average for the corresponding months since 1912. The rate, exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards, ranged from 9·46 in Maradana East to 22·99 in Kotahena North.

Deaths.

5. The total deaths registered during the month numbered 1,722 (958 males and 764 females). There were 1,341 deaths of residents in towns, equivalent to an annual standardized rate of 28·45 per 1,000, against 30·36 in the preceding month, 27·00 in the corresponding month of last year, 27·01 the average for the month of August in each year since 1912. The rate ranged from 60·17 in Batticaloa to 11·23 in Nuwara Eliya.

6. In the city of Colombo the deaths numbered 639 (363 males and 276 females). There were 532 deaths of residents, equivalent to an annual standardized rate of 29·34 per 1,000, against 31·99 in the preceding month, 22·42 in the corresponding month of last year, 25·82 the average for the month of August in each year since 1912. The rate, exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards, ranged from 31·26 in St. Paul's to 8·31 in Kollupitiya.

7. The stillbirths registered numbered 97 (52 males and 45 females), as against 110 in the preceding month.

Infant Mortality.

8. The mortality of infants under one year of age was equal to a rate of 206 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended August 31, 1922. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 229, against 261 in the preceding month, 248 in the corresponding month of last year, and 245 the average for the corresponding months since 1912.

9. In the city of Colombo the mortality of infants was equal to a rate of 202 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended August 31, 1922. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 239, against 301 in the preceding month, 246 in the corresponding month of last year, and 269 the average for the corresponding months since 1912.

Causes of Death.

10. The highest mortality was from *Pneumonia* to which 15 per cent. of the total deaths was due, *Debility* caused 9 per cent., *Convulsions* 6 per cent., *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia*, *Diarrhoea*, and *Phthisis* 5 per cent. each, *Dysentery* and *Anchylostomiasis* 4 per cent. each, *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis*, *Enteritis*, and *Influenza* 3 per cent. each, *Enteric Fever*, *Prematurity*, and *Bronchitis* 2 per cent. each, and *Puerperal Septicæmia* 1 per cent.

11. In Colombo, too, the highest mortality was from *Pneumonia*, which caused 16 per cent. of the deaths, *Debility* caused 9 per cent., *Phthisis* 7 per cent., *Convulsions* 6 per cent., *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis* 4 per cent., *Bronchitis*, *Influenza*, *Diarrhoea*, *Enteritis*, *Enteric Fever*, and *Dysentery*, 3 per cent. each, *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia*, *Prematurity*, and *Cancer* 2 per cent. each, and *Anchylostomiasis*, *Plague*, and *Puerperal Septicæmia* 1 per cent. each.

12. Eight deaths from *Plague* were registered (in Colombo), same as in the preceding month, and as against 3 in the corresponding month of last year. One death from *Smallpox* (in Jaffna) was also registered.

13. *Infectious Diseases reported.*—The infectious disease most prevalent during the month was *Phthisis*, of which 111 cases were reported (88 in Colombo, 11 in Chilaw), *Chickenpox* followed with 67 cases (25 in Colombo, 10 in Kandy, 10 in Ratnapura, 9 in Badulla), *Enteric Fever* 60 (45 in Colombo, 5 in Galle), *Measles* 27 (18 in Colombo, 8 in Kandy), *Continued Fever* 25 (14 in Colombo, 6 in Kandy), *Plague* 7 (in Colombo), *Dysentery* 7 (3 in Puttalam), *Smallpox* 7 (5 in Jaffna, 1 in Colombo, and 1 in Kalmunai), *Mumps* 4 (2 in Colombo and 2 in Kandy), and *Acute Diarrhoea* 1 (in Ambalangoda.)

Meteorology.

14. *Rainfall.*—Nawalapitiya recorded the highest rainfall (27·26 inches) followed by Hatton (18·66 inches). In the other towns it ranged from 6·73 inches in Nuwara Eliya to 0·06 of an inch in Vavuniya. Colombo recorded 1·11 inches.

15. *Temperature.*—The mean temperature varied from 60·6° in Nuwara Eliya to 86·0° in Trincomalee, and was 81·2° in Colombo.
