**VITAL STATISTICS OF TOWNS IN CEYLON IN THE  
MONTH OF SEPTEMBER, 1922.**

**REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL.**

THIS report deals with the Vital Statistics of the 33 principal towns in the Island proclaimed under sections 31–36 of the Ordinance No. 1 of 1895.

**Marriages.**

2. The marriages of residents in proclaimed towns numbered 354 (303 General, 3 Kandyan, and 48 Muhammadan), as against 296 in the preceding month. In Colombo the marriages of residents numbered 110 (80 General and 30 Muhammadan), as against 120 in the preceding month.

**Births.**

3. The births registered numbered 1,491 (773 males and 718 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 29·99 per 1,000, against 30·46 in the preceding month, 44·19 in the corresponding month of last year, and 27·56 the average for the corresponding months since 1912. The rate ranged from 15·11 in Kalpitiya to 59·16 in Hambantota.

4. In the city of Colombo the births registered numbered 549 (296 males and 253 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 26·97 per 1,000, against 26·44 in the preceding month, 52·82 in the corresponding month of last year, and 24·77 the average for the corresponding months since 1912. The rate, exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards, ranged from 12·13 in Kollupitiya to 28·25 in Kotahena North.

**Deaths.**

5. The total deaths registered during the month numbered 1,491 (791 males and 700 females). There were 1,157 deaths of residents in towns, equivalent to an annual standardized rate of 25·37 per 1,000, against 28·45 in the preceding month, 30·82 in the corresponding month of last year, 27·25 the average for the month of September in each year since 1912. The rate ranged from 52·97 in Anuradhapura to 9·63 in Hatton and Dikoya.

6. In the city of Colombo the deaths numbered 493 (255 males and 238 females). There were 419 deaths of residents, equivalent to an annual standardized rate of 23·88 per 1,000, against 29·34 in the preceding month, 29·31 in the corresponding month of last year, 26·00 the average for the month of September in each year since 1912. The rate, exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards, ranged from 21·92 in San Sebastian to 9·10 in Wellawatta North.

7. The stillbirths registered numbered 112 (67 males and 45 females), as against 97 in the preceding month.

**Infant Mortality.**

8. The mortality of infants under one year of age was equal to a rate of 185 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended September 30, 1922. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 203, against 229 in the preceding month, 182 in the corresponding month of last year, and 229 the average for the corresponding months since 1912.

9. In the city of Colombo the mortality of infants was equal to a rate of 186 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended September 30, 1922. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 202, against 239 in the preceding month, 137 in the corresponding month of last year, and 233 the average for the corresponding months since 1912.

**Causes of Death.**

10. The highest mortality was from *Pneumonia* to which 11 per cent. of the total deaths was due, *Debility* caused 9 per cent., *Phthisis* 8 per cent., *Convulsions* 6 per cent., *Diarrhoea* and *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia* 5 per cent. each, *Anchylostomiasis*, *Dysentery*, and *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis* 4 per cent. each, *Enteritis* and *Prematurity* 3 per cent. each, *Influenza*, *Enteric Fever*, and *Bronchitis* 2 per cent. each, and *Puerperal Septicæmia* and *Plague* 1 per cent. each.

11. In Colombo, the highest mortality was from *Phthisis*, which caused 11 per cent. of the deaths, *Pneumonia*, caused 10 per cent., *Debility* 8 per cent., *Convulsions* 6 per cent., *Influenza* 4 per cent., *Enteritis*, *Prematurity*, *Enteric Fever*, and *Anchylostomiasis* 3 per cent. each, *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis*, *Dysentery*, and *Diarrhoea* 2 per cent. each, and *Tetanus*, *Puerperal Septicæmia*, *Plague*, *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia*, and *Diabetes Mellitus* 1 per cent. each.

12. Fifteen deaths from *Plague* were registered (6 in Colombo and 9 in Galle), as against 8 in the preceding month, and *nil* in the corresponding month of last year. Two deaths from *Smallpox* (1 in Colombo and 1 in Anuradhapura) were also registered.

13. *Infectious Diseases reported.*—The infectious disease most prevalent during the month was *Phthisis*, of which 123 cases were reported (101 in Colombo, 13 in Galle), *Chickenpox* followed with 52 cases (25 in Colombo, 6 in Badulla), *Enteric Fever* 34 (27 in Colombo), *Measles* 20 (15 in Colombo), *Smallpox* 20 (15 in Colombo), *Plague* 19 (12 in Galle and 7 in Colombo), *Continued Fever* 13 (10 in Colombo), *Dysentery* 11 (4 in Weligama), *Mumps* 8 (6 in Colombo), and *Diphtheria* 2 (1 in Colombo and 1 in Kandy).

**Meteorology.**

14. *Rainfall.*—Nawalapitiya recorded the highest rainfall (28·64 inches), followed by Hatton (17·84 inches). In the other towns it ranged from 11·49 inches in Ratnapura to 0·17 of an inch in Batticaloa. Colombo recorded 1·36 inches.

15. *Temperature.*—The mean temperature varied from 60·8° in Nuwara Eliya to 86·6° in Trincomalee, and was 81·2° in Colombo.
