DRAFT ORDINANCES.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :---

An Ordinance further to amend "The Interpretation Ordinance, 1901."

THEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Interpretation Ordinance, 1901 ": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Interpretation amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1924." (Amendment) Ordinance, No.

2 "The Interpretation Ordinance, 1901," shall have effect, and be deemed always to have had effect, as though the following section were inserted between section 9 and section 10 thereof :

9 A. When any rules made under any Ordinance which has been repealed are kept in force by the repealing Ordinance, whether passed before or after the commencement of this Ordinance, such rules shall be deemed for all purposes to have been, and to be, made under the corresponding provisions of such repealing Ordinance, and shall be enforceable as if they had been so made.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

In several Ordinances there are provisions which are intended to keep in full operation rules made under repealed Ordinances. A doubt has lately arisen as to whether some sections by which such rules are kept in operation can, in all cases, be construed to retain the penal sanctions of such rules, and this Bill has been introduced to set at rest any such doubt. It is obvious that in all cases where rules under a repealed Ordinance have been retained in operation, the intention of the Legislature must have been that the penal sanction attached to them should also be kept alive.
