Order under Section 2 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Halambawelamukalana, Gonagalkandamukalana, &c., situate in the village of Awukana Vihare, in the Galegoda kandu tulana of the Negampaha korale of the Kalagam palata, in the North-Central Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."
