GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS.

Rule made by the Governor in Executive Council under Article LXIV. of "The Ceylon (Legislative Council)
Order in Council, 1923."

THE following proviso shall be added at the end of rule 12 of Schedule II. of the Order:—

Provided that if at any time after the adjournment of the election for the purpose of taking a poll the returning officer ascertains that the candidature of a candidate has been withdrawn by virtue of the provisions of rule 6A (1) of this schedule, and that by reason of such withdrawal the remaining candidate or candidates should, under rule 10 of this schedule, have been declared to be elected, the returning officer shall, notwith-standing the adjournment of the election as aforesaid, by writing under his hand declare that such candidate or candidates has or have been elected and shall transmit such declaration to the Colonial Secretary, who shall cause the election to be published in the Government Gazette.

"THE CEYLON (LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1923."

RULES made by the Governor in Executive Council, under the provisions of Article LXIV. of "The Ceylon (Legislative Council) Order in Council, 1923":—

- 1. Rule 13 (d) in Schedule II. of the said Order in Council is hereby amended by inserting the words "or the numbers of the voters on the register of voters" after the word "districts" in line 1 thereof.
- 2. Rule 15 in Schedule II. of the said Order in Council is hereby amended by inserting the words "or showing the numbers of the voters on such register" after the word "district" in line 3 thereof.
