### VITAL STATISTICS OF TOWNS IN CEYLON IN THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 1924.

#### REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL.

THIS report deals with the Vital Statistics of the 33 principal towns in the Island proclaimed under sections 31–36 of the Ordinance No. 1 of 1895.

##### Marriages.

2. The marriages of residents in the proclaimed towns numbered 418 (366 General, 3 Kandyan, and 49 Muhammadan), as against 346 in the preceding month and 328 in the corresponding month of last year. In Colombo the number of marriages was 139 (109 General and 30 Muhammadan), as against 123 in the preceding month and 116 in the corresponding month of last year.

##### Births.

3. The births registered numbered 1,600 (833 males and 767 females) and were equivalent to an annual rate of 30·62 per 1,000 of the population, as against 28·79 in the preceding month, 31·31 in the corresponding month of last year, and 28·89 the average for the corresponding months since 1914. The rate ranged from 12·02 in Vavuniya to 57·82 in Kegalle and 66·87 in Lunugala.

4. In the city of Colombo the births registered numbered 569 (290 males and 279 females) and were equivalent to an annual rate of 26·53 per 1,000, as against 27·32 in the preceding month, 27·69 in the corresponding month of last year, and 23·87 the average for the corresponding months since 1914. The rate, exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards, ranged from 12·65 in St. Paul's to 27·82 in Maradana East.

##### Deaths.

5. The total deaths registered during the month numbered 1,707 (944 males and 763 females). There were 1,291 deaths of residents in the towns equivalent to an annual standardized rate of 26·72 per 1,000, as against 25·24 in the preceding month, 28·93 in the corresponding month of last year, and 31·08 the average for the month of October in each year since 1914. The rate ranged from 70·31 in Vavuniya to 9·61 in Ambalangoda.

6. In the city of Colombo the deaths registered numbered 662 (381 males and 281 females). There were 559 deaths of town residents, which corresponded to an annual standardized rate of 30·01 per 1,000, as against 24·52 in the preceding month, 29·24 in the corresponding month of last year, and 28·46 the average for the month of October in each year since 1914. The rate, exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards, ranged from 26·96 in Maradana North to 8·63 in Kollupitiya.

7. The stillbirths registered during the month numbered 106 (55 males and 51 females), as against 90 in the preceding month.

##### Infant Mortality.

8. The deaths of children under one year amounted to 358 and corresponded to a rate of 227 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended October 31, 1924. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 224, as against 218 in the preceding month, 248 in the corresponding month of last year, and 241 the average for the corresponding months since 1914.

9. In the city of Colombo the deaths of children under one year numbered 137 and corresponded to a rate of 238 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended October 31, 1924. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 241, as against 206 in the preceding month, 255 in the corresponding month of last year, and 233 the average for the corresponding months since 1914.

##### Causes of Death.

10. The highest mortality was from *Pneumonia*, to which 11 per cent. of the total deaths were due. *Debility* (of children under 1 year) and *Phtisis*, each caused 7 per cent. of the deaths; *Diarrhoea* and *Convulsions*, each 6 per cent.; *Dysentery*, 5 per cent.; *Enteritis*, 4 per cent.; *Prematurity*, *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis*, *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia*, *Enteric Fever*, and *Anchylostomiasis*, each 3 per cent.; *Bronchitis*, 2 per cent.; *Puerperal Septicæmia*, *Influenza*, *Cancer*, *Tetanus*, and *Diabetes Mellitus*, each 1 per cent.

11. In Colombo the highest mortality was from *Phtisis*, to which 9 per cent. of the total deaths were due. *Pneumonia* caused 8 per cent. of the deaths; *Debility* (of children under 1 year), 7 per cent.; *Convulsions* and *Enteritis*, each 6 per cent.; *Diarrhoea*, *Lysentery*, *Bronchitis*, and *Enteric Fever*, each 4 per cent.; *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis*, 3 per cent.; *Prematurity*, *Influenza*, and *Cancer*, each 2 per cent.; *Anchylostomiasis*, *Tetanus*, and *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia*, each 1 per cent.

12. Two deaths from *Plague* (in Colombo) were registered, as against 3 in the preceding month and 12 in the corresponding month of last year.

13. *Infectious Diseases reported*.—The infectious disease most prevalent during the month was *Phtisis*, of which 128 cases were reported (112 in Colombo). *Measles* followed with 82 cases (46 in Colombo, 14 in Galle, 10 in Kandy); *Chickenpox* 79 (31 in Colombo, 20 in Moratuwa); *Enteric Fever* 76 (30 in Colombo, 12 in Kalutara, 10 in Galle); *Mumps* 35 (17 each in Colombo and Galle); *Continued Fever* 32 (28 in Colombo); *Dysentery* 7 (5 in Weligama and 2 in Panadure); *Smallpox* 7 (in Jaffna), and *Plague* 2 (in Colombo).

##### Meteorology.

14. *Rainfall*.—Nawalapitiya recorded the highest rainfall (17·95 in.). In the other towns the rainfall ranged from 15·07 in. in Gampola to 3·12 in. in Kalmunai. Colombo recorded 14·50 in.

15. *Mean Temperature*.—The mean temperature varied from 83·0° in Mannar and Trincomalee to 59·9° in Nuwara Eliya, and was 80·6° in Colombo.
