1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Supplementary Appropriation (1923-24) Ordinance, No. of 1925" : Short title.

2 The several sums of money appearing in the schedule hereto amounting in all to the sum of Eight million One hundred and Seventeen thousand Eight hundred and Seven rupees and Eighty-eight cents are hereby declared to be payable for the service of the Financial Year beginning on October 1, 1923, and ending on September 30, 1924, out of the revenue of the Colony for and in respect of the several services in the said schedule mentioned in addition to the sums appropriated by Ordinance No. 9 of 1923 : Appropriation.
