# FINAL ORDERS.

## Kurunegala S. O. No. 3,616.

#### Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Maragahahena, situate in the village of Alutwewa, in the Nikawagampaha korale of the Hiriyala hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 25th day of August, 1922, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Maragahahena, situate in the village of Alutwewa, in the Nikawagampaha korale of the Hiriyala hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, containing in extent 17 perches, and shown as lot 3 in block survey preliminary plan 1,881, was made to Walter Terence Stace, Esq., Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 8,167):
