Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Tirukkaikudakadu *alias* Totienuttu, situate in the village of Tirukkaikuda, in the Tamblegam pattu of the Trincomalee District, in the Eastern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on the 4th day of April, 1924, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Tirukkaikudakadu *alias* Totienuttu, situate in the village of Tirukkaikuda, in the Tamblegam pattu of the Trincomalee District, in the Eastern Province, containing in extent 3 acres and 30 perches, and shown as lot 8A in block survey preliminary plan 20, was made to Philip James Hudson, Esq., Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 8,571):
