### DRAFT ORDINANCES.

#### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

**An Ordinance to amend the Maintenance Ordinance, 1889.**

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Maintenance Ordinance, No. of 1925.

Short title.

2 The following section shall be inserted in the principal Ordinance between section 9 and section 10 thereof, viz. :

Insertion of new section in principal Ordinance.

9 A When disposing of any application or appeal under this Ordinance, the Police Court or the Supreme Court may order either party to pay all or any part of the costs of such application or of the costs of application and appeal, as the case may be, and such order shall be subject to the provisions and conditions laid down in the Civil Procedure Code, 1889, relating to costs so far as they may be applicable, and the amount due under the order shall be recoverable as if it were a fine, and in default of payment imprisonment of either description may be imposed for a period not exceeding one month.

Order as to costs, and enforcement thereof.

Provided that bills of costs shall be taxed according to the lowest rates specified in Schedule III. of the said Code under heads " Courts of Requests " and " Appeals from Courts of Requests."

Amendment of section 17 of the principal Ordinance.

3 Section 17 of the principal Ordinance, which now reads as follows, viz. :

Any person who shall be dissatisfied with any order made by a Police Magistrate under section 3 or section 14 may appeal to the Supreme Court, and every such appeal shall be subject to the provisions of section 407 of "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1883,"

is hereby amended so as to read as follows, viz. :

Any person who shall be dissatisfied with any order made by a Police Magistrate under section 3 or section 14 may prefer an appeal to the Supreme Court in like manner as if the order was a final order pronounced by a Police Court in a criminal case or matter, and sections 338 to 352 (inclusive) of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1898, shall apply to such appeal.

*Statement of Objects and Reasons.*

1. The object of this Ordinance is to correct two mistakes in the Maintenance Ordinance, 1889, which have been pointed out by judgments of the Supreme Court.

2. In the first place, there is no provision in the Ordinance similar to the provision in the English law for the awarding of costs of an application or appeal to the successful party.

3. In the second place, under the existing law there is no time limit provided for the filing of petitions of appeal.

4. These defects have been corrected by the addition of a new section to the Ordinance, and also by providing that the time limit should be fixed in the same way in which it is done in criminal cases.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

**An Ordinance to incorporate the Boy Scouts Association of Ceylon.**

Preamble.

WHEREAS an association, called and known as "The Boy Scouts Association of Ceylon" has heretofore been established in Ceylon for the purpose of effectually carrying out and transacting all matters connected with the said Association :

And whereas the said Association has heretofore successfully carried out and transacted the several objects and matters for which it was established, and has applied to be incorporated, and it will be for the public advantage to grant the said application. Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as "The Boy Scouts Association (Ceylon Branch) Ordinance, No. of 1925."

Incorporation of Boy Scouts Association of Ceylon.

2 From and after the passing of this Ordinance, the President, the Chief Commissioner, and trustees for the time being of the said Boy Scouts Association (Ceylon Branch) and such and so many persons as now are members of the said Boy Scouts Association (Ceylon Branch) or may hereafter be admitted members of the corporation hereby created, shall be and become a corporation with continuance for ever under the style and name of "The Boy Scouts Association (Ceylon Branch)" and by that name shall and may sue and be sued in all courts, with full power and authority to have and use a common seal and to change and alter the same at their pleasure.

- 3 The general objects for which the corporation is created are hereby declared to be to develop good citizenship among boys of all nationalities by forming their character, training them in habits of observation, obedience, and self-reliance, inculcating loyalty and thoughtfulness for others, teaching them services useful to the public and handicrafts useful to themselves, and by promoting their physical development and hygiene. General objects of the corporation.
- 4 (1) The affairs of the corporation shall, subject to the rules for the time being in force of the corporation as hereinafter provided, be administered by the Standing Committee for the time being of the Association. Standing Committee.
- This Standing Committee shall consist of the following persons :
- (a) The President of the Association.
- (b) The Chief Commissioner.
- (c) Not less than two other members to be elected respectively in accordance with the rules for the time being of the corporation.
- (d) Two trustees.
- (e) Two members nominated by the Chief Commissioner. Trustees.
- (2) The first trustees shall consist of the Hon. Mr. Cecil Clementi, C.M.G., Colonial Secretary, and C. Brooke Elliott, Esq., K.C. Trustees.
- 5 The Standing Committee for the time being shall have full power and authority to make rules for the better management and regulation of the affairs of the corporation, and when made, revoke, vary, or amend such rules, and all members of the said corporation shall be subject to the rules in force for the time being of the said corporation. Rules.
- 6 On the coming into operation of this Ordinance all and every property belonging to the said Boy Scouts Association (Ceylon Branch), whether held in the name of the said Boy Scouts Association (Ceylon Branch), or in the name or names of any person or persons, or bodies corporate in trust for the said Boy Scouts Association (Ceylon Branch), shall be and the same are hereby vested in the corporation hereby created, and the same, together with all after-acquired property, both movable and immovable, and all subscriptions, contributions, fines (see section 7), donations, legacies, amounts of all loan, and advances received or to be received, shall be held by the said corporation for the purposes of this Ordinance, and subject to the rules in force of the said corporation. Property vested in corporation.
- 7 All debts and liabilities of the said Boy Scouts Association (Ceylon Branch) existing at the time of the coming into operation of this Ordinance shall be paid by the corporation hereby constituted, and all debts due to, and subscriptions, contributions, and fines payable to, the said Boy Scouts Association (Ceylon Branch) shall be paid to the said corporation for the purposes of this Ordinance. Debts due by and payable to the corporation.
- 8 The seal of the corporation shall not be affixed to any instrument whatsoever except in the presence of the two trustees, who shall sign their names to the instrument in token of their presence, and such signing shall be independent of the signing of any person as a witness. The seal of the corporation to be affixed.
- 9 The corporation shall be able and capable in law to take and hold any property, movable or immovable, which may become vested in it by virtue of any purchase, grant, gift, testamentary disposition, or otherwise, and all such property shall be held by the corporation for the purposes of this Ordinance, and subject to the rules for the time being of the said corporation, with full power to sell, mortgage, lease, exchange, or otherwise dispose of the same. Corporation may hold property movable and immovable.
- 10 Nothing in this Ordinance contained shall prejudice or affect the rights of His Majesty the King, his heirs and successors, or of any body politic or corporate, or of any other persons, except such as are mentioned in this Ordinance, and those claiming by, from, or under them. Saving as to rights of His Majesty and others.

- (a) The Association is permanently established in Colombo.  
 (b) The Association has a certain amount of property, and hopes to acquire more in the future.  
 (c) The Boy Scouts Association is a world-wide institution, and in other parts of the world it is incorporated.  
 (d) Institutions of a similar nature in Ceylon are incorporated by special Ordinances.

The general objects for which the corporation is constituted are set out fully in section 3 of the Draft Ordinance.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice  
and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 6 of 1925.

An Ordinance to declare the Batticaloa Waterworks to be  
vested in the Ceylon Government.

C. CLEMENTI.

WHEREAS an arrangement for the construction of water-  
works at a total cost of one hundred and forty-six  
thousand rupees for the use of the Local Board town of Batti-  
caloa was made in the year 1914 between the Government  
and the Local Board of Batticaloa :

Preamble.

And whereas it was a term of the said arrangement that the  
Government should contribute the sum of eighty-four thousand  
rupees towards the cost of construction and that the balance  
was to be met by the Local Board out of a loan of sixty-two  
thousand rupees to be made to the said Board by the Govern-  
ment and to be repaid by a sinking fund at the rate of two  
and half per centum per annum together with interest at the  
rate of three and half per centum per annum :

And whereas the said waterworks were duly constructed  
by the Government and were handed over to the said Local  
Board as from the thirty-first day of March, 1917 :

And whereas in the year 1918 by agreement with the Government the said Local Board handed over the property in, and the management and control over, the said works to the Government on the terms that the Government should provide such a water supply for the use of the said town as circumstances would permit and that the proceeds of the water-rate to be levied by the Local Board under the provisions of section 44 of Ordinance No. 13 of 1898 should be paid by the said Local Board to the Government and that the Local Board should be relieved of the liability for payment of interest and sinking fund on the loan aforesaid :

And whereas it is desirable to make fit and proper provision with a view to removing any doubts as to the respective rights and duties of the Government and of the said Local Board in the premises :

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title and commencement.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Batticaloa Water works Ordinance, No. 6 of 1925," and shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Governor in Executive Council by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*.

Transfer of Batticaloa Waterworks to Ceylon Government.

2 (1) The waterworks, hereinbefore referred to, constructed by the Government for the use of the Local Board town of Batticaloa and the land on which the said works stand shall belong to and be vested in the Government, and all tanks, reservoirs, cisterns, fountains, wells, aqueducts, conduits, tunnels, pipes, pumps, or other waterworks existing at the commencement of this Ordinance, or afterwards made, laid, or erected, and whether made, laid, or erected at the cost of the Government or otherwise, and all rights, servitudes, bridges, buildings, engines, works, materials, and things connected therewith or appertaining thereto, shall be vested in the Government.

(2) The Government shall have the right of breaking open the soil at any place, including the right of digging up and opening any street, road, or lane, for the purpose of constructing, laying, altering, or repairing any part of the said waterworks : Provided that the Government shall with all convenient speed, after such work has been completed, restore the ground broken open to its former condition.

Duty of Government to supply water within Local Board limits.

3 (1) Subject to the performance by the said Local Board of the obligations undertaken by, or imposed on, them under this Ordinance, the Government shall provide a supply of drinking water within the Local Board town of Batticaloa, and shall for that purpose cause such pipes to be laid, and such tanks, reservoirs, or other works to be made, as are necessary for the supply of wholesome water in the public streets of the Local Board town of Batticaloa, and shall erect in such streets convenient standpipes, fountains, open reservoirs or pumps for the gratuitous use of the inhabitants of the said Local Board town of Batticaloa for domestic purposes. It shall also, subject to the performance of the obligations of the said Local Board hereinbefore mentioned, be the duty of the Government, as far as possible, to make adequate provision that such supply of water shall be continuous throughout the year, and that the water supplied shall be at all times fit for human consumption.

(2) A supply of water for domestic purposes shall not include a supply of water for horses or cattle or for washing vehicles, where such horses, cattle, or vehicles are kept for sale or hire, or a supply for any trade, manufacture, or business, or for fountains or swimming baths, or for any ornamental or mechanical purpose, or for purposes of irrigation.

(3) The Government may supply water for other than domestic purposes, or allow a private service of water to any house for domestic purposes, in such quantities and upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon between it and the persons desirous of being so supplied.



4 (1) As a contribution to the cost and maintenance of the said waterworks, the said Local Board agrees, and it is hereby empowered, to impose, annually, a water-rate on the annual value, ascertained in the manner provided by section 31 of "The Local Boards Ordinance, 1898," of all houses, buildings, lands, and tenements within the limits of the Local Board town of Batticaloa. Such rates shall be imposed on or before the thirty-first day of December in each year, or on such other date as may be fixed by agreement between the Government and the said Local Board.

Imposition of water-rate and relief of Board from repayment of loan.

(2) The amount of such water-rate shall be fixed from time to time by the Governor in Executive Council, but shall in no case exceed six per centum on such annual value as aforesaid, and shall be paid and recovered in the same manner as the police tax is directed to be paid and recovered under "The Police Ordinance, 1865," as amended by any subsequent enactment, and shall be subject in all respects to the provisions of that Ordinance as amended as aforesaid relating to the payment and recovery of such police tax. The Government Agent of the Eastern Province shall collect and recover such rate, and shall pay it into the Colonial Treasury.

(3) And it is hereby declared and agreed that in consideration of, and subject to the performance of their obligations under, the agreement above set forth, the said Local Board shall be relieved from all and every liability to repay to the said Government the loan of sixty-two thousand rupees hereinbefore recited, or any part thereof, or to pay any interest, or make any contribution towards any sinking fund, in respect of the said loan.

5 The Governor in Executive Council may, by notification in the *Government Gazette*, exempt either wholly or partially from the said water-rate any premises, which, in his opinion, are not sufficiently supplied with water from such waterworks, and may from time to time revoke such exemption.

Exemption from payment of water-rate.

6 In the event of the said Local Board refusing, neglecting, or failing to impose a water-rate as hereinbefore provided, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Executive Council to impose such water-rate and to empower the Government Agent of the Eastern Province to collect and recover the water-rate in the manner and subject to the same conditions as if such water-rate had been duly imposed by the said Local Board.

Procedure on failure of Local Board to impose water-rate.

7 The obligations under this Ordinance imposed on, or undertaken by, the said Local Board shall be transferred to and carried out by any successor of the Board constituted under "The Local Government Ordinance, No. 11 of 1920," or any Ordinance amending the same.

Obligations of Board to be carried out by successor.
