FINAL ORDERS.

Ratnapura S. O. No. 847.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903,"
declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Panwilamukalana, Hedawakamukalana, &c. (exclusive of the streams and paths passing through the land), situate in the village of Mapota, in the-Palle pattu of the Kuruwiti korale of the Ratnapura District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."
