## FINAL ORDERS.

Kurunegala S. O. No. 3,801.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903,"  
declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Weliyayahena or Kongahamulahena, Andaralandehenyaya, &c., situate in the village of Munamalegama, in the Pahalawisideke korale of the Wannī hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on the 18th day of August, 1922, that if no claim to the lands commonly called or known as Weliyayahena or Kongahamulahena, Andaralandehenyaya, &c., situate in the village of Munamalegama, in the Pahalawisideke korale of the Wannī hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, containing in extent 104 acres and 5 perches, and shown as lots 1, 1c, 5, 46, 46B, 51, 52, 52A, 53A, 56, 69, and 44A in block survey preliminary plan No. 1,846, was made to Maxwell MacLagan Wedderburn, Esq., special officer appointed under section 23 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such lands would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (*vide* Notice No. 8,159):

Father Joseph Fernando, O.M.I., on behalf of (17) Most Reverend Anthony Coudert, O.M.I., Archbishop of Colombo, made claim to the above-mentioned lots 56 and 69; and whereas (18) Walahegawa Sumatiratna, (19) Bandaratna Mudiyaśelage Dingiri Banda, (20) Bandaratne Mudiyaśelage Mutumenika, and (21) Bandaratne Mudiyaśelage Suddahamy made claim to the above-mentioned lots 44A, 46, and 46B; and whereas (22) Tennakoon Mudiyaśelage Lucas Banda Tennakoon made claim to the above-mentioned lots 51, 56, and 69; and whereas (23) Basnayake Mudiyaśelage Kirihamy made claim to the above-mentioned lots 44A, 56, and 69; and whereas (24) Baptist de Silva Abeyaratne made claim to the above-mentioned lots 52, 52A, and 53A; and whereas (25) Vana Pana Lana Sawanna Annamalay Chetty made claim to the above-mentioned lots 1, 1c, 51, 52, 52A, and 56; and whereas (26) Abdul Carder Carder Saibo made claim to the above-mentioned lots 44A, 46, 46B, 51, and 56; and whereas T. before Maxwell MacLagan Wedderburn, Esq., the aforesaid Special Officer, the evidence and documents upon which she might rely in proof of her claim, did not so appear or produce such evidence or documents; I, Mungo Tennent Archibald, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me in that behalf by section 4 of the said Ordinances, do hereby on this 31st day of October, 1925, order and declare under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, that the said lands, as more fully described herein below, are the property of the Crown.
