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FINAL ORDERS.

Kurunegala S. O. No. 3,801.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Weliyayahena or Kongahamulahena, Andaralandehenyaya, &c., situate in the village of Munamalegama, in the Pahalawisideke korale of the Wanni hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

 W_{HEREAS} in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on the 18th day of August, 1922, that if no claim to the lands commonly called or known as Weliyayahena or Kongahamulahena, Andaralandehenyaya, &c., situate in the village of Munamalegama, in the Pahalawisideke korale of the Wanni hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, containing in extent 104 acres and 5 perches, and shown as lots 1, 1c, 5, 46, 46B, 51, 52, 52A, 53A, 56, 69, and .44A in block survey preliminary plan No. 1,846, was made to Maxwell.
