FINAL ORDERS.

Ratnapura S. O. No. 889.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Ulugalakoratuwa *alias* Madawalehena, situate in the village of Madola, in the Helapalle pattu of the Meda korale of the Ratnapura District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 9th day of July, 1920, that if no claim was made in writing by the said land commonly called or known as Ulugalakoratuwa *alias* Madawalehena, situate in the village of Madola, in the Helapalle pattu of the Meda korale of the Ratnapura District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, and shown as lot 96D in block survey preliminary plan No. 203, was made to Mungo Tennent Archibald, Esq., Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown and dealt with on account of the Crown (see Notice No. 7,563):
