The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to make provision for the granting of Pensions to Teachers in Assisted Schools.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title and commencement.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the School Teachers Pension Ordinance, No. of 1927, and shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by the Governor by Proclamation in the "Government Gazette."

Definition of "assisted school." 2 In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, "assisted school" means a school to which aid is contributed from the public funds of the Colony.

Pensions charged on general revenue 3 There shall be paid out of moneys provided for the purpose by the Legislative Council all such sums of money as may from time to time be granted by way of pension, gratuity, or other allowance by the Governor in Executive Council in accordance with this Ordinance and any rules made thereunder to persons who have been employed as teachers in assisted schools.

Power to make rules.

- 4 (1) The Governor in Executive Council may, if he thinks fit, from time to time make, alter, and revoke rules for the granting of pensions, gratuities, and other allowances to persons who have been employed as teachers in assisted schools.
- (2) All such rules shall, as soon as conveniently may be, be laid before the Legislative Council, and may, at any of the next following three meetings, be rescinded by resolution of the Legislative Council, but without prejudice to anything already done thereunder, and if not so rescinded shall be deemed to be valid.

No absolute right to pension.

- 5 (1) No person shall have any absolute right to compensation for past services or to any pension, gratuity, or other allowance under this Ordinance or any rules made thereunder.
- (2) Nothing in this Ordinance or any rules made thereunder shall limit any power or right to dismiss without compensation any person employed as a teacher in an assisted school.

Pension not seizable.

1

6 No pension payable under this Ordinance shall be assignable or be liable to seizure or sequestration by any process of law or vest in any receiver, assignee, or trustee in insolvency or bankruptcy.

This Ordinance will enable rules to be made for the granting of pensions to persons who have been employed as teachers in assisted schools.

2. The Ordinance provides that the rules shall be laid on the table of the Legislative Council, and may be rescinded by resolution of the Legislative Council.

> An Ordinance for making provision for the Public Service for the Financial Year 1927-28.

> BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance of 1927.

Appropriation for year 1927-28.

2 Without prejudice to any other law authorizing any expenditure, a sum not exceeding one hundred and fifty-eight million six hundred and ninety thousand three hundred and forty three rupees is hereby declared to be payable for the service of the financial year beginning on October 1, 1927, and ending on September 30, 1928, out of the revenue of the Colony, and the said sum may be expended as specified in the schedule to this Ordinance.
