**VITAL STATISTICS OF TOWNS IN CEYLON IN THE  
MONTH OF MARCH, 1927.**

**REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL.**

THIS report deals with the Vital Statistics of the 33 principal towns in the Island proclaimed under sections 31-36 of the Ordinance No. 1 of 1895.

**Marriages.**

2. The number of marriages of residents in proclaimed towns numbered 279 (264 General, 3 Kandyan, and 12 Muslim), as against 398 in the preceding month and 356 in the corresponding month of last year. In Colombo the number of marriages was 113 (104 General and 9 Muslim), as against 132 in the preceding month and 148 in the corresponding month of last year.

**Births.**

3. The births registered numbered 1,915 (939 males and 976 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 35·43 per 1,000 of the population, as against 35·79 in the preceding month, 35·51 in the corresponding month of last year, and 30·26 the average for the corresponding months since 1917. The rate, exclusive of the small towns Mullaivivu, Vavuniya, and Lunugala, ranged from 16·76 in Anuradhapura to 61·39 in Kegalla. There were 1,720 births of children whose mothers were residents of the towns, equivalent to an annual rate of 31·82, as against 31·90 in the preceding month.

4. In the city of Colombo the births registered numbered 790 (384 males and 406 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 35·53, as against 39·44 in the preceding month, 31·24 in the corresponding month of last year, and 26·20 the average for the corresponding months since 1917. The rate, exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards, ranged from 15·72 in Kollupitiya to 33·10 in Slave Island. There were 683 births of children whose mothers were residents of the city, equivalent to an annual rate of 30·72, as against 33·51 in the preceding month.

**Deaths.**

5. The total deaths registered during the month numbered 1,516 (797 males and 719 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 28·05, as against 30·83 in the preceding month. There were 1,172 deaths of residents in the towns, equivalent to an annual standardized rate of 23·45, as against 24·99 in the preceding month, 23·54 in the corresponding month of last year, and 28·68 the average for the corresponding months since 1917. The standardized death rate, exclusive of the small towns Mullaivivu, Vavuniya, and Lunugala, ranged from 60·83 in Mannar to 8·82 in Ambalangoda.

6. In the city of Colombo the deaths registered numbered 596 (322 males and 274 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 26·81, as against 29·78 in the preceding month. There were 473 deaths of residents of the city which corresponded to an annual standardized rate of 24·50, as against 26·95 in the preceding month, 22·62 in the corresponding month of last year, and 27·15 the average for the corresponding months since 1917. The death rate of residents, exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards, ranged from 25·88 in New Bazaar to 9·71 in Kollupitiya.

7. The stillbirths registered during the months numbered 127 (84 males and 43 females), as against 130 in the preceding month.

**Infant Mortality.**

8. The deaths of children under one year amounted to 335 and corresponded to a rate of 182 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended March, 1927. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 175, as against 178 in the preceding month, 167 in the corresponding month of last year, and 224 the average for the corresponding months since 1917. There were 306 deaths of children under one year whose mothers were residents of the towns, which corresponded to a rate of 178, as against 180 in the preceding month.

9. In the city of Colombo the deaths of children under one year numbered 132, and corresponded to a rate of 186 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended March, 1927. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 167, as against 155 in the preceding month, 164 in the corresponding month of last year, and 236 the average for the corresponding months since 1917. There were 117 deaths of children under one year, whose mothers were residents of the city, which corresponded to a rate of 171, as against 165 in the preceding month.

**Causes of Death.**

10. The highest mortality was from *Pneumonia*, to which 14 per cent. of the total deaths were due. *Convulsions* and *Debility* (of children under one year), each caused 7 per cent.; *Phthisis*, 6 per cent.; *Anchylostomiasis* and *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia*, each 4 per cent.; *Diarrhoea*, *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis*, *Enteritis*, *Dysentery*, and *Bronchitis*, each 3 per cent.; *Prematurity*, *Enteric Fever*, *Puerperal Septicaemia*, and *Influenza*, each 2 per cent.; *Tetanus*, 1 per cent.

11. In Colombo too the highest mortality was from *Pneumonia*, to which 13 per cent. of the total deaths were due. *Phthisis* caused 9 per cent.; *Debility* (of children under one year) 7 per cent.; *Convulsions* 5 per cent.; *Bronchitis* 4 per cent.; *Influenza*, *Enteritis*, *Diarrhoea*, *Plague*, and *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis*, each 3 per cent.; *Anchylostomiasis*, *Enteric Fever*, *Cancer*, *Prematurity*, and *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia*, each 2 per cent.; *Dysentery*, *Puerperal Septicaemia*, and *Tetanus*, each 1 per cent.

12. Fifteen deaths (14 males and 1 female) from *Plague* were registered in Colombo, as against 7 in the preceding month and 1 in the corresponding month of last year.

13. *Infectious Diseases reported.*—The infectious disease most prevalent during the month was *Chickenpox*, of which 250 cases were reported (169 in Colombo, 33 in Galle, 11 in Nuwara Eliya), *Phthisis* followed with 93 (79 in Colombo, 5 in Galle); *Enteric Fever* 46 (18 in Colombo, 7 in Kalutara, 6 in Galle); *Continued Fever* 26 (21 in Colombo); *Plague* 19 (in Colombo); *Measles* 16 (9 in Colombo, 4 in Kandy); *Mumps* 6 (5 in Colombo, 1 in Nuwara Eliya); *Dysentery* 4 (1 each in Moratuwa, Kalutara, Hambantota, and Batticaloa); *Diphtheria* 2 (in Colombo); *Whooping Cough* 2 (in Colombo); *Smallpox* 1 (in Colombo Harbour).

**Meteorology.**

14. *Rainfall.*—Batticaloa recorded the highest rainfall (17·64 in.). In the other towns the rainfall ranged from 16·61 in. in Ratnapura to 1·50 in. in Jaffna. Colombo recorded 5·91 in.

15. *Mean Temperature.*—The mean temperature varied from 83·3° in Jaffna to 60·6° in Nuwara Eliya, and was 81·0° in Colombo.
