### PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS His Excellency Sir HUGH CLIFFORD, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon with the Dependencies thereof, has quitted this Colony. It is hereby proclaimed that by virtue of the Letters Patent passed under the Great Seal of the United Kingdom, constituting the Office of Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Island of Ceylon and its Dependencies, dated the Eleventh day of September, One thousand Nine hundred and Twenty, the Honourable Mr. ARTHUR GEORGE MURCHISON FLETCHER, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, has this day assumed the Administration of the Government of the Island, of which all persons concerned are required to take due notice.

Given at Colombo, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Twenty-ninth day of May, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Twenty-seven.
