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**DRAFT ORDINANCE.****MINUTE.**

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

**An Ordinance to amend the Ceylon Telegraph Ordinance, 1908.**

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Ceylon Telegraph Ordinance, No. of 1926.

Working of wireless telegraphs on foreign ships.

2 The following section shall be inserted between section 8 and section 9 of the principal Ordinance, viz. :

8A. (1) A person shall not work any apparatus for wireless telegraphy installed on a foreign ship whilst that ship is in any port or the territorial waters of Ceylon, otherwise than in accordance with regulations made in that behalf by the Governor in Executive Council.

(2) Such regulations may impose a fine not exceeding two hundred rupees for the breach of any such regulation and provide for the forfeiture of any apparatus for wireless telegraphy worked in breach of any such regulation.

(3) All regulations made under this section shall be published in the Gazette, and shall, as soon as conveniently may be, be laid before the Legislative Council, and may, at any of the next following three meetings, be rescinded by resolution of the Legislative Council, but without prejudice to anything already done thereunder, and if not so rescinded shall be deemed to be valid.

(4) In this section, "foreign ship" includes a foreign man-of-war and aircraft accompanying a foreign ship.

*Statement of Objects and Reasons.*

THIS Ordinance will give power to the Governor in Executive Council to make regulations as to the use of wireless telegraphy on foreign ships and aircraft in the ports and territorial waters of Ceylon, there being no such power contained in the Ceylon Telegraph Ordinance, No. 35 of 1908.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

**No. 1 of 1926.**

**An Ordinance to amend the Telegram Copyright Ordinance, 1898.**

HUGH CLIFFORD.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Telegram Copyright Ordinance, No. 1 of 1926.

Deletion of "electric."

2 The word "electric" shall be deleted from section 1 and sub-section (1) of section 4 of the principal Ordinance.

3 Section 3 of the principal Ordinance, which now reads as follows, viz. :

Amendment of section 3 of the principal Ordinance.

Telegraphic messages published under the protection of this Ordinance shall be printed under the heading "By Submarine Telegraph," and shall state the day and hour of their receipt, and such statement shall be *prima facie* evidence of the time of the receipt of such messages.

is hereby amended so as to read as follows, viz. :

Telegraphic messages published under the protection of this Ordinance shall be printed under the heading "Telegram Copyright Ordinance, 1898," and shall state the day and hour of their receipt, and such statement shall be *prima facie* evidence of the time of the receipt of such messages.

4 The following section shall be inserted in the principal Ordinance between sections 6 and 7 thereof, viz. :

Insertion of new section in principal Ordinance.

6A. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, the expression "telegraph" includes telephone and wireless telegraph or telephone, and "telegraphic" has a corresponding meaning.

Definition of "telegraph."

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for  
 general information:—

#### An Ordinance to amend the Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund Ordinance, 1898.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the  
 advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof,  
 as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Widows' and  
 Orphans' Pension Fund Ordinance, No. of 1926.

Exemption of  
 pensions from  
 estate duty.

2 The following section shall be inserted in the principal  
 Ordinance as section 33:

33. No pension to which a widow or child of a deceased  
 public officer dying after the commencement of this Ordinance  
 becomes entitled under this or any other Ordinance  
 relating to the pensions of the widows or children of deceased  
 public officers shall be liable to the payment of estate duty  
 under the Estate Duty Ordinance, No. 8 of 1919.
