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## FINAL ORDERS.

### Matale S. O. No. 194.

#### Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," admitting Land to be Private Property.

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Diggalahenyaya, situate in the village of Diggala, in the Gampahasiya pattu of the Matale South division of the Matale District, in the Central Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances, 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on the 6th day of April, 1923, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Diggalahenyaya, situate in the village of Diggala, in the Gampahasiya pattu of the Matale South division of the Matale District, in the Central Province, containing in extent 3 acres and 9 perches, and shown as lot 18K in block survey preliminary plan No. 71, was made to Walter Terence Stace, Esq., Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (*vide* Notice No. 8,317):

And whereas (1) Pallegedera Heen Bandiya, (2) Pallegedera Salindu, and (3) Pallegedera Meniki made claim thereto, and I, Mungo Tennent Archibald, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, made due inquiry into such claim; I do hereby, in pursuance of the agreement dated the 1st day of February, 1924, admit the claim of the said claimants under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances to the said land, as more fully described herein below, and as described in the survey and description thereof, authenticated by Arthur Joseph Wickwar, Esq., Surveyor-General, bearing date the 23rd May, 1925, No. 368,189/F. O. T. P.
