The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :---

An Ordinance to amend the Chanks Ordinance, 1890.

S 261/26

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Chanks Ordinance, No. of 1927.

Amendment of section 4 of the principal Ordinance.

Short title.

2 In sub-section (1) of section 4 of the principal Ordinance, the words "not exceeding one cent on each chank" are hereby repealed, and the following shall be added at the end of that sub-section, viz. :

"Every notification under this section shall, as soon as conveniently may be, be laid before the Legislative Council, and may at any of the next following three meetings be rescinded by resolution of the Legislative Council, but without prejudice to anything already done thereunder, and if not so rescinded shall be deemed to be valid."

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THE following is an extract from the report of the Marine Biologist dated August 30, 1926, on the Madras Fisheries :---

"(1) The chank fisheries of Madras are illuminating. The fishery is directly under the control of the Madras Fisheries Department. All the chanks fished above a minimum size are purchased by the Madras Government from the divers at a fixed rate of one anna per chank or Rs. 62.5 per thousand. The chanks are then sold at a contract rate to merchants. The number of chanks fished by the Madras Government in 1922-23 was 466,540. These were sold at Rs. 207.7.0 per thousand, the Madras Government thus making a gross profit of Rs. 145.2.0 per thousand. The gross receipts were Rs. 97,912.11.8, and the nett profit realized from the fishery Rs. 46,367.

"(2) In Ceylon the chank fisheries, which are limited to that part of the Palk Strait off the Jaffna islands, are not a Government monopoly but are free to all comers. The only revenue which accrues to Government from these fisheries is an export duty of Rs. 2 to Rs. 6 per thousand chanks. During the year 1923, 2,520,086 chanks were fished in Ceylon waters, and the revenue collected was Rs. 12,565 (vide Administration Report of Government Agent, Northern Province, for 1923). Thus, whereas the Madras Government received a gross revenue of Rs. 97,912.11.8 for 466,540 chanks fished, the Ceylon Government received less than one-seventh of this sum for more than five times the number of shells. I am assured that Ceylon and Indian chanks are of equal value; therefore it is reasonable to suppose that were it possible to conduct the Ceylon chank fisheries on similar lines to the Madras chank fisheries, the resulting revenue would exceed the total votes of my Department for 1926-27, viz., Rs. 134,884.'

2. The Government consider that the best course to adopt is to raise the export duty on chanks and accordingly propose that the export duty should be raised to Rs. 15 per thousand for live chanks, Rs. 7.50 per thousand for dead chanks, and Rs. 5 per thousand for immature chanks.

Under section 4 of the principal Ordinance the Governor, 3. with the advice of the Executive Council, is authorized to appoint the rate which should be paid as royalty, but it is provided that the rate so fixed shall not exceed one cent on each chank or Rs. 10 per thousand chanks.

The object of this Ordinance is to remove the maximum rate fixed by the principal Ordinance and enable the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, to alter the rates as circumstances require. Any alteration in the rate will be laid on the table of the Legislative Council and may be rescinded by resolution of the Legislative Council.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THIS Ordinance gives effect to the recommendations contained in the Second Interim Report of the Taxation Commission for the amendment of the duties in schedule B to the Stamp Ordinance, 1909.

2. Opportunity has been taken to alter the wording of the proviso in Parts II. and III. of schedule B to the Stamp Ordinance relating to the stamp duty on exhibits so as to make it clear that the lower duty of 12 cents on an exhibit or translation is only to come into operation after ten exhibits or translations which are subject to stamp duty have been filed, it having been recently held by a District Judge that the lower duty becomes applicable even though the first ten exhibits filed are, by reason of the document exhibited having been stamped, exempt from duty.

3. The paragraph in Part III. of that schedule relating to the valuation of estates of persons dying after July 1, 1919, has also been altered so as to make it clear that for the purposes of stamp duty in testamentary proceedings only those items of property are to be taken into account for the administration of which probate or letters of administration are required.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 11 of 1927.

An Ordinance to Incorporate the Young Men's Buddhist Association, Colombo.

H. J. STANLEY.

WHEREAS an association, called and known as "The Young Men's Buddhist Association, Colombo," has heretofore been established at Colombo for the purpose of effectually carrying out and transacting all matters connected with the said association according to the rules agreed to by its members:

And whereas the said association has heretofore successfully carried out and transacted the several objects and matters for which it was established, and has applied to be incorporated, and it will be for the public advantage to grant the application :

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

1 This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as the Young Men's Buddhist Association, Colombo, Ordinance, No. 11 of 1927.

2 From and after the passing of this Ordinance the President, Vice-Presidents, and members of the Committee of Management for the time being of the said Young Men's Buddhist Association, Colombo, and such and so many persons as now are members of the said Young Men's Buddhist Association, Colombo, or shall hereafter be admitted members of the corporation hereby constituted, shall be and become a corporation with continuance for ever under the style and name of "The Young Men's Buddhist Association, Colombo," and by that name shall and may sue and be sued in all courts, with full power and authority to have and use a common seal and alter the same at their pleasure.

3 The general objects for which the corporation is constituted are hereby declared to be (a) the study and propagation of Buddhism, (b) the encouragement of the practical observance of Buddhism, (c) the promotion of unity and co-operation among Buddhists, and (d) the advancement of the physical, intellectual, and social welfare of the members.

4 (1) The affairs of the corporation shall, subject to the rules in force for the time being of the corporation as hereinafter provided, be administered by a Committee of Management consisting of the President, five Vice-Presidents, the Honorary General Secretary, and Honorary Treasurer respectively of the corporation and not less than seventeen other members, to be elected respectively in accordance with rules for the time being of the corporation.

Preamble.

General objects of the corporation.

Committee of Management. (2) All members of the corporation shall be subject to the rules in force for the time being of the corporation.

(3) The first Committee of Management shall consist of D. B. Jayatilaka, Esq., M.A., M.L.C., President; W. A. de Silva, Esq., J.P., M.L.C.; Dr. C. A. Hewavitarne, M.R.C.S.; D. C. Senanayake, Esq.; A. E. de Silva, Esq., B.A.; D. S. Senanayake, Esq., M.L.C., Vice-Presidents; C. Victor Perera, Esq., Honorary General Secretary; T. W. Gunawardene, Esq., J.P., Mudaliyar, Honorary Treasurer; Dr. D. B. Perera; Chas. Dias, Esq., Proctor; N. J. V. Cooray, Esq., Proctor; H. A. de Abrew, Esq.; J. D. A. Abeywickrama, Esq.; S. B. Ranasinha, Esq.; R. S. S. Gunawardana, Esq.; B.A., Advocate; H. Guneratna, Esq.; D. N. W. de Silva, Esq.; Thomas Rodrigo, Esq., Mudaliyar; W. E. Bastian, Esq.; V. S. Nanayakkara, Esq.; L. A. Jayasekara, Esq.; D. C. Abeygunawardana, Esq.; and D. N. Hapugala, Esq.

5 It shall be lawful for the corporation from time to time, at any general meeting of the members, and by a majority of votes to make rules for the admission, withdrawal, or expulsion of members; for the conduct of the duties of the Committee of Management and of the various officers, agents, and servants of the corporation; for the procedure in the transaction of business; and otherwise generally for the management of the affairs of the corporation and the accomplishment of its objects. Such rules when made may, at a like meeting, be altered, added to, amended, or cancelled, subject, however, to the requirements of section 7.

6 Subject to the provisions in the preceding section contained, the rules set forth in the schedule hereto shall for all purposes be the rules of the corporation, provided, however, that nothing in this section contained shall be held or construed to prevent the corporation at all times hereafter from making fresh rules, or from altering, amending, adding to, or cancelling any of the rules in the schedule hereto or to be hereafter made by the corporation.

7 No rule in the schedule hereto, nor any rule hereafter passed at a general meeting, shall be altered, added to, amended, or cancelled, except by a vote of two-thirds of the members present at a general meeting of the association, provided that such amendment shall have been previously approved by the Committee of Management.

8 On the coming into operation of this Ordinance all and every the property belonging to the said Young Men's Buddhist Association, Colombo, whether held in the name of the said Young Men's Buddhist Association, Colombo, or in the name or in the names of any person or persons in trust for the said Young Men's Buddhist Association, Colombo, shall be and the same are hereby vested in the corporation hereby constituted, and the same, together with all after acquired property, both movable and immovable, and all subscriptions, contributions, donations, amounts of loan, and advances received or to be received, shall be held by the said corporation for the purposes of this Ordinance and subject to the rules in force for the time being of the said corporation.

9 All debts and liabilities of the said Young Men's Buddhist Association, Colombo, existing at the time of the coming into operation of this Ordinance shall be paid by the corporation hereby constituted, and all debts due to and subscriptions and contributions payable to the said "Young Men's Buddhist Association, Colombo," shall be paid to the said corporation for the purposes of this Ordinance.

10 The seal of the corporation shall not be affixed to any instrument whatsoever except in the presence of two of the members of the Committee of Management, who shall sign their names to the instrument in token of their presence, and such signing shall be independent of the signing of any person as a witness.

The corporation shall be and capable in law to take 11 and hold any property, movable or immovable, which may become vested in it by virtue of any purchase, grant, gift, testamentary disposition, or otherwise, and all such property shall be held by the corporation for the purposes of this Ordinance and subject to the rules for the time being of the said corporation, with full power to sell, mortgage, lease, exchange, or otherwise dispose of the same.

Corporation may hold property, movable and immovable.

Saving as to the rights of His Majesty

12 Nothing in this Ordinance contained shall prejudice or affect the rights of His Majesty the King, his heirs, and successors, or of any body politic or corporate or of any other persons, except such as are mentioned in this Ordinance and those claiming by, from, or under them.

SCHEDULE.

Rules of the Young Men's Buddhist Association, Colombo.

1. Designation.—This association shall be called "The Young Men's Buddhist Association, Colombo.'

Objects.-The objects of this association shall be-

- (a)
- The study and propagation of Buddhism. The encouragement of the practical observance of Buddhism. (b)
- The promotion of unity and co-operation among Buddhists.
- The advancement of the physical, intellectual, and social (d)welfare of members.

Membership.--(a) Men, not less than eighteen years of age, 3. having any or all of the above objects in view, are eligible for membership.

(b) Members shall be classified as honorary, active, and life members.

(c) Any person who has rendered distinguished service to the cause of Buddhism may be elected as an honorary member at a General Meeting of the association.

(d) Active members shall pay a minimum subscription of Re. 1 a month, or Rs. 10 a year or Rs. 5 a half year, payable in advance during the first month of each period.

(e) Any person who gives a donation of not less than Rs. 200 to the association may be elected as a life member.

(f) Every application for membership, countersigned by a member as referee, shall be forwarded to the Honorary General Secretary, who shall submit it to the Committee of Management for approval.

(g) If an active member be in arrears of subscription for a period of six months, his name may be removed from the roll of members after giving him a fortnight's notice. He may not be re-elected until the arrears due from him are paid.

(h) Any member whose conduct is found to be detrimental to the interests of the association may after investigation be suspended or his rame removed from the roll by the Committee of Management at a meeting of the same specially convened for the purpose, if two-thirds of those voting approve of such suspension or removal, voting being by ballot. The quorum at such a or removal, voting being by ballot. meeting shall be not less than ten members

4. Management.—(a) The affairs of the association shall be administered by a Committee of Management consisting of a President, five Vice-Presidents, an Honorary General Secretary, and an Honorary Treasurer, who shall be ex officio members of the Committee of Management, and not less than seventeen other members, to be elected at the Annual General Meeting of the association. They shall hold office for one year or until their successors shall have been elected and have entered upon their duties.

b) The various activities of the association shall be in charge of Departmental Committees consisting of five members each, of whom four shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting and the other nominated by the Committee of Management from among its members. Such nominee of the Committee of Management shall be the Secretary and Convener of the Committee to which he is appointed.

(c) All officers and members of Committees shall be Buddhists.

(d) The President, or in his absence one of the Vice-Presidents, shall be the Chairman at the meetings of the association. If neither the President nor one of the Vice-Presidents be present, a member shall be voted to the chair. The Chairman shall have a casting vote.

(e) The Honorary General Secretary shall keep a record of all meetings of the association and of the Committee of Management, a register of members, and any other record that may be necessary.

(f) The Honorary Treasurer shall receive and keep accounts of all moneys and funds belonging to the association, and shall make such payments as are authorized by the Committee of Management. He shall prepare and submit a duly audited statement of accounts at the Annual General Meeting, and his books shall be open to the inspection of members at all reasonable times.

(g) Meetings of the Committee of Management shall be held at least once a month. Upon the written requisition of three members of the Committee of Management the President shall have a meeting of the Committee convened to transact such business as is intimated in the notice calling the meeting. Five days' notice shall be given to the members of any such special meeting. Five members shall form the quorum at all meetings of the Committee of Management.

(h) In the case of any vacancies occurring during the year among the Officers or in the Committee of Management, or in Departmental Committees, the Committee of Management shall have power to fill such vacancies for the unexpired term.

(i) The Committee of Management shall have power to make rules for its own government and for the management of the association and its departments provided that such rules are not inconsistent with this constitution.

(j) The Committee of Management shall hold and administer for the purposes of the association all property belonging to the association. It shall also have power, with the consent of a twothirds majority of members present at a General Meeting of the association, to sell, mortgage, lease, exchange or otherwise dispose of the immovable property belonging to the association. Provided that such decision be confirmed at a subsequent General Meeting held within one month.

5. General Meetings of the Association.—(a) The Annual General Meeting of the association shall be held in the month of February, at which the reports of the Committee of Management and of the Honorary Treasurer shall be presented.

(b) The Honorary General Secretary shall convene a General Meeting of the association upon the request of the Committee of Management, or upon the written requisition of not less than twenty-five members.

(c) A fortnight's notice shall be given of any general meeting, and twenty members shall constitute the quorum at such meeting.

6. Auditor.—The members shall elect at the Annual General Meeting of the association a qualified auditor, who shall audit the accounts of the association for the ensuing year. In the event of an auditor so appointed not being able to act through any cause, the Committee of Management shall have power to elect another auditor.

7. Branches.—Branch associations may be established wherever possible in the Island under such conditions as shall be determined by the Committee of Management. All such associations shall be worked on the same principles as defined in these rules. A certificate of affiliation shall be issued to branches so formed.

8. Amendment of Constitution — This constitution can be amended or altered only by a vote of two-thirds of those present at a General Meeting of the association, provided that such amendment shall have been previously approved by the Committee of Management. A fortnight's notice shall be given to the members of any proposed a teration of the rules.






