The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to make Supplementary Provision for the Public Services for the Financial Year 1924-25.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

- Short title.** 1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Supplementary Appropriation (1924-25) Ordinance, No. of 1926"
- Appropriation.** 2 The several sums of money appearing in the schedule hereto amounting in all to the sum of Rupees Two million One hundred and Ninety-two thousand and Eighty-seven and Cents Nine are hereby declared to be payable for the service of the Financial Year beginning on October 1, 1924, and ending on September 30, 1925, out of the revenue of the Colony for and in respect of the several services in the said schedule mentioned in addition to the sums appropriated by Ordinance No. 23 of 1924.
