An Ordinance to make Supplementary Provision for the Public Services for the Financial Year 1924-25.

E it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Supplementary Appropriation (1924-25) Ordinance, No. of 1926

Appropriation.

2 The several sums of money appearing in the schedule hereto amounting in all to the sum of Rupees Two million One hundred and Ninety-two thousand and Eighty-seven and Cents Nine are hereby declared to be payable for the service of the Financial Year beginning on October 1, 1924, and ending on September 30, 1925, out of the revenue of the Colony for and in respect of the several services in the said schedule mentioned in addition to the sums appropriated by Ordinance No. 23 of 1924.

No. 3 of 1926.

An Ordinance to amend the Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund Ordinance, 1898.

HUGH CLIFFORD.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund Ordinance, No. 3 of 1926.

The following section shall be inserted in the principal Ordinance as section 33:

No pension to which a widow or child of a deceased public officer dying after the commencement of this Ordinance becomes entitled under this or any other Ordinance relating to the pensions of the widows or children of deceased public officers shall be liable to the payment of estate duty under the Estate Duty Ordinance, No. 8 of 1919.

No. 4 of 1926.

An Ordinance to amend the Ceylon Telegraph Ordinance, 1908.

HUGH CLIFFORD.

E it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

This Ordinance may be cited as the Ceylon Telegraph Ordinance, No. 4 of 1926.

Short title.

Exemption of pensions from

estate duty.

- The following section shall be inserted between section 8 and section 9 of the principal Ordinance, viz.:
 - 8A. (1) A person shall not work any apparatus for wireless telegraphy installed on a foreign ship whilst that ship is in any port or the territorial waters of Ceylon, otherwise than in accordance with regulations made in that behalf by the Governor in Executive Council.
 - (2) Such regulations may impose a fine not exceeding two hundred rupees for the breach of any such regulation and provide for the forfeiture of any apparatus for wireless telegraphy worked in breach of any such regulation.
 - (3) All regulations made under this section shall be published in the Gazette, and shall, as soon as conveniently may be, be laid before the Legislative Council, and may, at any of the next following three meetings, be rescinded by resolution of the Legislative Council, but without prejudice to anything already done thereunder, and if not so rescinded shall be deemed to be valid.
 - (4) In this section, "foreign ship" includes a foreign man-of-war and aircraft accompanying a foreign ship.
