In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Kalawgahayayerugahamulahena, situate in the village of Kirioruwa, in the Udogoda Udasiya pattu of the Matale north division of the Matale District, in the Central Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."
