ORDERS. FINAL

Kurunegala S. O. No. 3,882.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Kongahahena, Kahatagahahenyaya, situate in the village of Ihala Timbiriwewa, in the Yagam pattu korale of the Katugampola hatpattu of the Kurunegela District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."
