# Kurunegala S. O. No. 3,889.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Banakiyannagamawewahena, Kumbukgahamulahenyaya, situate in the village of Banakiyannagama, in the Karanda pattu korale of the Katugampola hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

Whereas in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 6th day of November, 1925, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Banakiyannagamawewahena, Kumbukgahamulahenyaya, situate in the village of Banakiyannagama in the Karanda pattu korale of the Katugampola hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, containing in extent 2 acres and 10 perches, and shown as lot 2 in block survey preliminary plan No. 2,109, was made to Mungo Tennent Archibald, Esq., Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 8,950);

O. T. P. (L. L. No. 933).
