DRAFT ORDINANCE.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance for making provision for the Public Service for the Financial Year 1926-27.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance of 1926. Short title.

2 Without prejudice to any other law authorizing any expenditure, a sum not exceeding one hundred and thirty-one million three hundred and twelve thousand six hundred and fourteen rupees is hereby declared to be payable for the service of the financial year beginning on October 1, 1926, and ending on September 30, 1927, out of the revenue of the Colony, and the said sum may be expended as specified in the schedule to this Ordinance. Appropriation for year 1926-27.
