DRAFT ORDINANCES.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend the Game Protection Ordinance, 1909.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Game Protection Ordinance, No. of 1926.

Restriction on export of living birds.

2 (1) The following section shall be inserted in Part VI. of the principal Ordinance immediately before section 30, viz. :

29 A. (1) No person shall, without the licence of the Governor, export from Ceylon any living bird of a species specified in the sixth schedule, or export any such bird otherwise than in accordance with any conditions contained in the licence.

(2) But any person leaving the Island may without a licence take with him not more than two specimens of each such species.

(3) The Governor in Executive Council may from time to time by notice published in the Gazette alter or add to the sixth schedule.

Provided that any alteration or addition to the said sixth schedule shall not come into operation unless and until it is confirmed by a resolution of the Legislative Council.

(4) This section shall have effect as though it formed part of Ordinance No. 17 of 1869 entitled "An Ordinance for the General Regulation of Customs in the Island of Ceylon."

(2) In section 26 of the principal Ordinance, the words "in schedule IV., V., or VI." shall be substituted for the words "in either schedule IV. or V."

3 The following shall be substituted for schedule IV. to the principal Ordinance, viz. :

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THE Game Protection Ordinance of 1909 gives no power to prohibit or restrict the export of live birds from the Island.

2. The Government of Fiji recently asked for leave to export several hundred specimens of insectivorous birds from Ceylon to Fiji to cope with a caterpillar pest. Since then it has been ascertained that bird fanciers in Europe are inquiring locally for the wholesale supply of small parrots, &c. It is, therefore, desirable that Government should have power to regulate any export trade in caged birds. Accordingly section 2 of the Ordinance prohibits the export of living birds of a species specified in the sixth schedule except with the licence of the Governor. The sixth schedule enumerates 16 species of useful or ornamental species in which an export trade would at present be likely.

3. Power is given to alter or add to the schedule, subject to confirmation by the Legislative Council.

4. The opportunity has been taken to revise schedules IV. and V. to the principal Ordinance. No new birds or reptiles have been added to or omitted from these schedules, but the scientific names of the various species have been added, and, where necessary, the English and vernacular names have been corrected.

An Ordinance to amend the Societies' Ordinance, 1891.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Societies' Ordinance, No. of 1926.

Amendment of section 8 (1) (d) of principal Ordinance.

2 The following shall be inserted at the end of subparagraph (d) of paragraph (1) of section 8 of the principal Ordinance, viz. :

Provided that the Governor in Executive Council may by notification in the Gazette order that, as respects any specially authorized society, the return shall be made out to, and be sent to the Registrar on, such days as may be specified in the notification.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

SECTION 8 (1) (d) of the Societies' Ordinance, 1891, requires societies governed by the Ordinance to submit annually an audited statement of accounts (called a "return") made out to December 31. This provision is suitable for mutual provident societies, but has given rise to difficulty in the case of the Ceylon Training Colony, a "specially authorized society," to which the Ordinance has been applied under section 3 (2). This society, the objects of which are educational, is compelled by circumstances to make up its accounts to the end of the scholastic year, viz., August 31. It thus becomes necessary for the society to have two audits in each year—an unnecessary expense. This Ordinance enables the Governor in Executive Council to order that as respects any specially authorized society, the accounts shall be made out to and be sent to the Registrar on special dates.
